
3. Scholarships

There are 3 categories of scholarships for international students according to application procedure:

1. Waseda University Scholarships (Waseda University scholarship system), p.81
2. External Scholarships with University Recommendation (screening by Waseda University)—you may only apply for scholarships posted by your school/graduate school, p.91

3. Open External Scholarships (open application)—please apply directly to the organization. Application information is posted by each school/graduate school, p.127

*As a rule, application information and materials will be available at the school/graduate school office.

The following is a list of major scholarships. However, please note that you may not be able to apply for all scholarships as eligibility and application requirements differ by school/graduate school and year of study. Furthermore, these scholarships target regular privately financed international students*. Consequently, recipients of the Japanese Government Scholarship (Monbukagakusho), students supported by overseas governments, and those who receive scholarships from scholarship organizations toward their tuition, as well as non-degree research students are not eligible to apply.

*Most scholarships require a “college student” or “student” visa status to apply. However, some scholarships of type (1) only require that the applicant is NOT a “permanent resident” (*eijusha*), “long-term resident” (*teijusha*), or a “spouse of a Japanese resident (or permanent resident)”.

Each scholarship’s announcement and selection will be conducted through the school/graduate school office in one of the following ways.

- A. Scholarship announcement is posted on the school/graduate school bulletin board (please follow eligibility and application procedures as indicated).
- B. After selection of suitable candidates for an organization’s application requirements, the school/graduate school will notify students directly.

※Foreign nationals with a resident status of “permanent resident” (*eijusha*) “long-term resident” (*teijusha*), “spouse of a Japanese resident,” or “spouse of a permanent resident” can apply for scholarships in the same way as Japanese students. In this case, there are different application procedures, and you do not need to submit the “Scholarship Registration Form” (for international students). Please check the details with your respective school office.
