Application Guidelines

At Waseda University, we will be hosting the 2010 Global Honors College with 8 other universities; Columbia University, Harvard University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), University of Washington (Seattle), Yale University, National University of Singapore, Peking University and Korea University. This program theme is "Environment and Sustainability" and aims for students to take a look at a world scale issue, through group work and discussions, etc., enabling them to come up with some solutions.

1. Program Name: "Global Seminar on Sustainability 2010"

The 2010 Global Honors College program is made of two parts, the online based "Online Phase (Online Distance Learning)" and the part at Waseda University the "Onsite Phase (Summer Intensive Program)". The two combined is one program and is each worth 2 credits. It is a requirement that applicants join both phases consecutively.

* Your major will not affect the screening process as we will be observing this program from a wide prospective. Humanities, Social Sciences and Liberal Arts students are also welcome.

Language of Instruction: English

Phase 1: Online Phase

Course Title: Global Seminar on Sustainability I (Offered by the CIE: 2 credits)
Period: Early June ~ Late July, 2010 (approx. 8 weeks; Details to be announced)

Students and faculty from the above mentioned top universities of North America and Asia will be able to learn, have discussions, research, complete assignments and connect this to the phase 2, summer intensive program at Waseda University. Phase 1 is to start early June and will kick off with Harvard University's Professor James Engell's remote TV lecture.

Phase 1 is scheduled to finish late July.

Phase 2: Onsite Phase – Summer Intensive Program

Course Title: Global Seminar on Sustainability II (Offered by the CIE: 2 credits) Period: August 2nd ~ August 20th, 2010 (3 weeks)

Students and faculty from the above mentioned top universities of North America and Asia will visit and attend the phase 2 – Summer Intensive Program at Waseda University over the period of 3 weeks. Based on the achievements of phase 1, we will be looking deeper into the topic and research further, finally presenting our findings. Suited for the "Honors Program", during phase 2 of the program all

students including those from Waseda University will be asked to stay at Waseda University's dormitories in order to have a more in depth learning/research experience and share intercultural backgrounds.

To join this program, it is a requirement to be able to join both phases 1 & 2 and complete the two phases.

6. Application Requirements

- 1. The applicant must be able to have enough English knowledge to have a discussion at a high level.
- 2. The applicant may be enrolled in any discipline of study but have a high interest in the program theme.
- 3. Able to attend all process of the phase 1 and 2.
- 4. The applicant must be a regular undergraduate student at Waseda University as of April 1st, 2010. However, applicants who are on a study abroad or on a leave of absence as of April 1st, 2010, are not qualified.

Please deliver the following documents to the Center for International Education office.

- 1. Statement of purpose as to why you want to join the program.

 Please write about your past experiences, what you would like to do and learn through this program. The letter must be written in English and contained on 1 page of A4 paper.
- -2. Most recent academic transcript in English.
- 3. Original and valid TOEFL or IELTS score sheet.

 (TOEIC, "Eiken" and such other official examination scores are also acceptable)
- 4. A recommendation letter from a full-time faculty at Waseda University.
 (There are no particular styles or forms for the recommendation letter and may be written in English or Japanese)
- 5. Application Form (Assigned Form)
- 6. One (1) photo (3x4cm)

Please write your name and student ID number on the back and attatch it to the above "5.Application Form".

8. Program Costs

GHC program: Free

Also, Waseda University will be borne all fees regarding points below 1. ~ 3:

- 1. Program fee necessary for this program

 - 2. During phase 2 of the program, 3 weeks of accommodation at one of Waseda Univeristy's dormitories (Meals are not included)

- 3. Round trip chartered bus for the field trip (planning still in process)

Meals will not be offered at Waseda University's dormitories. All other expenses except the ones mentioned above will be the responsibility of students.
