The University has grown into a full-fledged University with 73 recruiting units in 9 colleges, 116 master and doctoral courses in six graduate schools, with 22,992 students and 1,690 faculty and staff members.</p> <p>In the age of globalization, leaders should have open-minded intellect and perspective in accordance with the global standard.
