Overview: Course Description

The financial system is an integral part of the economy as infrastructure to support business and society. When the system functions properly, it can distribute funds from savings to investments under asymmetric information. This course provides an overview of the key elements, functions, and structures of the financial systems and arguments arising in financial markets and thorough intermediaries. The discussions in this course focus on the Japanese financial system and the financial systems several Asian developing countries.
