Submission Eligibility of Survey Papers as Master Thesis

A master student satisfying the following criteria is allowed to submit a survey paper as a master thesis.

- i. By the beginning of the final semester, students are required to earn 8 credits from the following courses.

- ii. Submitted papers are evaluated by three faculty members in oral examinations.
- iii. A student who submits a survey paper for a master thesis will not be eligible to apply for the admission to the Ph.D. course by recommendation (i.e., the student must take the entrance exam), unless the student has already enrolled in the 5-year Ph.D. program.
- iv. This rule is applied to all master students of the GSE.
