3. ゆうちょ銀行口座の開設について

学習奨励費を受け取るためにはゆうちょ銀行口座を開設しなければなりません。郵便局でゆうちょ銀行通常預金口座を開設し、上記の通り必要書類を提出してください。

4. 奨学金概要

(1) 奨学金額:月額48,000円

(2) 支給期間:2016年4月から2017年3月まで(12ヶ月)

- (3) 受給資格:以下の条件をすべて満たしている人が対象となります。
 - ①2016年度に正規生として在籍する私費外国人留学生
 - ② 在留資格が「留学」である者または「留学」への変更手続き中の者
 - ③学業、人物ともに優れ、経済的理由により修学に困難があり援助が必要であると認められる者
 - ④ 仕送りが平均月額90.00円以下であること(学費は含まない)
 - ⑤ 学習奨励費との併給制限のある奨学金を受給する予定ではないこと
 - ⑥ 在日扶養者がいる場合、年収が500万円未満であること
 - (7) 学習奨励費受給後に、機構が在籍大学等を通じて行う進路状況調査に協力できる者

5. その他

- ・申請にあたっては、「学生証」「在留カード(留学ビザの確認のため)」を忘れずに持参して ください。
- ・本奨学金に申請するためには、所属事務所で在籍確認簿に署名をする必要があります。
- ・正式な採用通知は7月上旬にお知らせします。
- ・採用された場合、4月、5月、6月分の奨学金はまとめて7月15日(水)に振り込まれます

Application Guideline Academic Year 2016 Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

- 1. Documents to be submitted
 - ①Application Form: Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students
 - **②Postal Savings Account Information Sheet for "Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Stundents"**
 - (3) A copy of the first page of your postal savings account passbook (attach to (2))
 - **(4)** A copy of your "Residence card" (both sides)
- 2. Where to submit: Office of your undergraduate or graduate school office Deadline: April 25th. Monday
- 3. Opening a Postal Savings Account

In order to receive the Honors Scholarship, you have to open an ordinary savings account at Japan Post Bank (Post Office) and submit the documents as directed above.

- 4. Description of Scholarship
 - 1) Scholarship amount: 48,000 yen/month
 - 2) Scholarship duration: April 2016 through March 2017 (12 months)
 - 3) Eligibility: Students who meet all of the following requirements.
 - (1) Privately financed international students who are currently enrolled as regular students.
 - (2) Students whose residency status is "College Student" or who are currently in the process of changing it to "College Student".
 - (3) Students recognized as both academically and personally outstanding who are having difficulty pursuing their studies for economic reasons and are acknowledged to be in need of financial support
 - (4) Students whose average allowance is 90,000 yen or less per month except school fees
 - (5)Students who will not receive any other scholarship(s) that are not allowed to combine with Honors Scholarship
 - (6) The annual income of their financial supporter residing in Japan may not exceed 5 million yen.
 - (7) The scholarship recipients should cooperate with JASSO's survey of academic and carrier status after scholarship payment.

5. Others

- When you apply, please show your student ID card and certificate of alien registration / residence card (to confirm your college student visa).
- You need to sign up on "the sheet of enrollment" at the office of your undergraduate or graduate school to apply for this scholarship.
- You will receive the formal notice of determination by the beginning of July.
- If you are selected as a recipient, the scholarship payment for April, May, and June will be made together on July 15th.
