You may choose other courses that you are interested in from the complete list. If you are interested in credit transfer, you need to consult with your academic advisor at your home university. Course submission for credit transfer approval should be completed prior to your departure.
- You are required to enroll at least 3 credits per semester. However, it is normal that the international students are enrolling between 3 – 15 credits per semester.
- Applicants have the necessary pre-requisite background, if required by the host Faculty.
- Approval to enroll in courses is given by the relevant Faculty office.
