

International Joint Project 2009 < Kuroda Project >

In GSAPS, since last year, the “Union of High Level Empowerment of Human Resources in East Asia Program,” which is part of “Program for Enhancing Systematic Education in Graduate Schools,” has received authorization of the project by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology –Japan (MEXT). The goal of the project is “to empower the Scholars’ and Experts’ self-dependence through systematic approach,” which is lacking in the Japanese Graduate Schools. Also, the program wishes “to empower the Scholars’ and Experts’ group work involving high cohesive projects” of European and American Graduate Schools. By uniting the two goals, it will be able to reach the aim, which is to promote the empowerment of human resources into higher level through the union.

This year, GSAPS will implement International Joint Project as part of this program. To those students who take all the course work and submit the report, will be offered maximum of 150,000 yen for the travel fee and accommodation fee with credits (2 credits as Non-credit courses offered at GSAPS) for the summer semester. Those students who are interested in this program should read the following details and apply according to the procedure.

Content of Activity:

- 9 July 2009 (Thu.)
 - Depart at Narita/Tokyo
 - After Arriving in Bangkok, register International Conference on Higher Education Research and Development (IHERD). This conference is organized by Dhurakij Pundit University in collaboration with Commission on Higher Education Office of the Education Council and others.

- 10 July 2009 (Fri.)
 - Attending and presenting research at IHERD

- 11 July 2009 (Sat.)
 - Same as above

- 12 July 2009 (Sun.)
 - Same as above

- 13 July 2009 (Mon.)
 - Visit UNESCO Asia-Pacific Education Office
 - Depart from Bangkok at night

- 14 July 2009 (Tue.)
 - Morning: Arrive in Narita

Precautions:

- During the stay, all participating students may need to pay part or all of fee on transportation and meals.
- Those who will take the “International Joint Project” will receive 2 credits; however, the credits will not be counted as needed graduation credits and register as Non-credit courses.
- Those who have already joined the International Joint Project of GP 2008 can also apply this program again, but successful applicants will only receive the half of the maximum of the provided aid (75,000 yen), in principle.
- At present, those who are applying to the projects for “Summer School” and/or “UN • World Bank Project” may not apply.
- We are planning to call for the entry to two more program this year.(Look below for

- Date: 18 November – 21 November 2009
- Head Supervisor: Professor G.S. Roberts
- Destination: Vancouver, Canada
- Content: Attend the international conference, engage with University of British Columbia, etc

《3rd project》

- Date: 21 February– 27 February 2010
- Head Supervisor: Professor Goto Kenichi
- Destination: Indonesia
- Content: Engage with workshops performed by Universities in Indonesia, Attend to actual field works performed by international organization with corporations, etc

Application standard

- Applicants qualification:
 - Must be a graduate student from Graduate School of Asian Pacific Studies, Waseda University. (Those who meet the assured research paper and the requirements mentioned above will receive the priority to be selected first. Those who will not present the research paper will be given a constant role during the visits to UNESCO and etc.)
- Requirements:
 - Must download the application paper from the “University Graduate of Education GP” from the website (<http://www.waseda.jp/gsaps/index.html>).
 - Attach the required essay (The topic must follow the directions on the Application, may be written either Japanese or English. Must be written on a A4 paper and answered less than one page)
- Number of applicants
 - Maximum of 10 students

- Deadline of the Application
 - 5 June 2009 (Fri) noon

- Location where Applications should be Submitted
 - 7th floor- in front of the office there will be mail box (Caution: will not receive any emails)

The Schedule after the deadline:

- Notification of acceptance
 - After Monday, June 8, pass or fail is reported directly from the secretariat to the applicant through a strict examination. Please acknowledge not corresponding to the inquiries (reason of failure) other than the pass or fail result at all so.
