About ESP: TESOL

ESP:TESOL is an intensive (25 hours per week) five-week English language course.

ESP:TESOL enables students to:

- improve their English communication skills
- develop their knowledge and understanding of current English language teaching methods

- learn practical activities which can be used for teaching English
- develop English language and classroom management skills
- prepare and deliver practice teaching sessions
- become familiar with and have practice for the Cambridge English Language Assessment Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT).
- Students will sit the following two test modules according to the course taken.
 - [ESP:TESOL A] Module 1 (Background to language teaching) and KAL (Knowledge About Language)
 - [ESP:TESOL B] Module 2 (Planning for language teaching) and Module 3 (Classroom Management)

Please note: While ESP:TESOL contains content related to teaching English the course is not a formal teaching qualification.

Students should arrive in Brisbane on Sunday 21 February 2016 and depart on Friday 25 March 2016.

ACCOMMODATION

The ESP:TESOL program includes accommodation with an Australian homestay family. Homestay is an excellent opportunity to experience Australian culture and practise your English. You will have your own private bedroom and be welcomed to join the family in all shared living areas of the home.

Homestay includes breakfast and dinner on weekdays and breakfast, lunch and dinner on weekends.

ICTE-UQ homestay is managed by the Institute's experienced accommodation officers and all families are visited before being accepted into the program.

Transport to/from the UQ St Lucia campus is usually by bus and/or train and on average takes 30-40 minutes up to a maximum of 50-60 minutes.

PROGRAM PRICE

AUD\$ 3727

(includes partner university reduction)

The program price includes tuition fees and course materials, 2 TKT modules, homestay accommodation, return Brisbane airport transfers (arrival and departure).

Please note that the program price does not include airfares or compulsory health and travel insurance.

Students should also budget approximately

- AUD\$ 50 per week for weekday lunches (Monday - Friday) - weekend lunches are included with homestay accommodation
- AUD\$ 35-40 per week for public transport to and from campus
- Costs for other personal expenses
