**Title : Natural Assets in National Accounts (Green GDP) - Practical Issues**



(概要)

This seminar will discuss how to adjust a Social Accounting Matrix (SAM) to account for the contribution of natural assets in gross domestic product. Typically, natural resources like water or land are not explicitly included in SAMs. I will present a methodology that estimates Water's contribution to GDP and embed the results in a dynamic, multi-region, multisector model to estimate sectoral water shadow (rental) values

across regions over time, and then use the shadow rental values to estimate unit stock prices of water over time.
