Profile of Speaker:

Dr. Mario Giampietro is a research professor of Institute of Environmental Science and Technology of Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona and has a Ph.D. in Social Sciences from Wageningen University in Netherlands. He has worked on integrated assessment of sustainability issues for many years and is well-known as a developer of Multi-Scale Integrated Analysis of Societal and Ecosystem Metabolism, which links between the metabolism of socio-economic systems and the potential constraints of the embedding natural environment. He has more than 150 scientific publications in the prestige journals such as Ecological Economics, Energy, and Nature and is also the author of several books. He is one of the leading environmental scientists in European region.

Getting to Waseda Campus:

The nearby subway station is Waseda Station (T04) on the Tokyo Metro Tozai Line (Blue T line). At the station, please take Exit 3a. Once you get to the ground level, please walk to the left and turn left at the first corner. If you walk for about a block, you will see South Gate of Waseda University. Instead of entering the Waseda Campus through the South Gate, please walk to the right until you see another gate of the university, the Main Gate.

Getting to Prof. Arimura's Office on Waseda Campus:

Prof. Arimura's Office is located on the 12th floor (the office number is 1213) of Building No.3 on the Waseda Campus. You can find Building No.3 right at the center of the campus map. There are several ways to come here, but it would be the easiest if you come through the Main Gate. Please turn right after the first building and enter the entrance No.2 on the map. It is dark-grayish manual door. This is the direct entrance to the elevator hall. There is an automated sliding door next to this door on the right hand side, but please do not enter that door as it would take you into the main spacious entry area that you wish to avoid.

The information above is for you not to get lost as you find the elevators[lifts]. The elevators are "hidden" in Building No.3 and it's not easy to find them. Please remember that it doesn't mean you are getting anywhere if you walk into the main spacious entrance area with escalators.
