#### 講義概要

This course is intended for graduate students who plan to present their research findings in an international setting requiring the use of English. The focus of the semester will be on the skills necessary to enable students to become proficient in making presentations. All three of the major areas of presentation will be covered. In the area of physical skills, practice will be given not only in pronunciation, but also in matters such as the projection of the voice, appropriate posture, the use of gesture, and eye contact. As for the necessary rhetorical skills, questions such as content, structure, and coherence will be addressed, though, to this end, it will be useful to have taken the complementary Academic Writing Course in the first semester. The third area, visual skills, will deal with the effective preparation of visual aids, including the use of computer software such as PowerPoint. This course takes a very practical approach, with much of the time devoted to actual presenting.
