After completing your graduate study, you need to have the capability to complete publishable papers in

established academic journals by yourself. First, you write a review paper on your research topic. After

that, we have regular meetings to proceed the research. To complete Ph.D., you complete at least one

paper individually. Moreover, I recommend that you write at least one empirical paper.

3. Both theoretical and empirical studies are indispensable for the study of asset pricing. Because my

research is theory-oriented, you have to master financial econometrics by yourself.
