UTSA Exchange Fast Facts

Requirements:

- Minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Official copy of all academic transcripts
- Application Fee: \$60
- TOEFL or IELTS examination

Minimum Scores:

- TOEFL Internet: 79TOEFL Paper: 550
- IELTS: 6.5

Important Dates:

- Fall Nomination Deadline: 1 April
- Fall Application Deadline: 1 May
- Fall Semester Begins: 21 August
- Fall Semester Final Exams: 8-14 December

Visa Requirements:

Once accepted, a student visa is required. This process usually takes about 8-10 weeks. Students must provide proof from a financial institution of sufficient funds (Minimum of \$1,500 per month).
