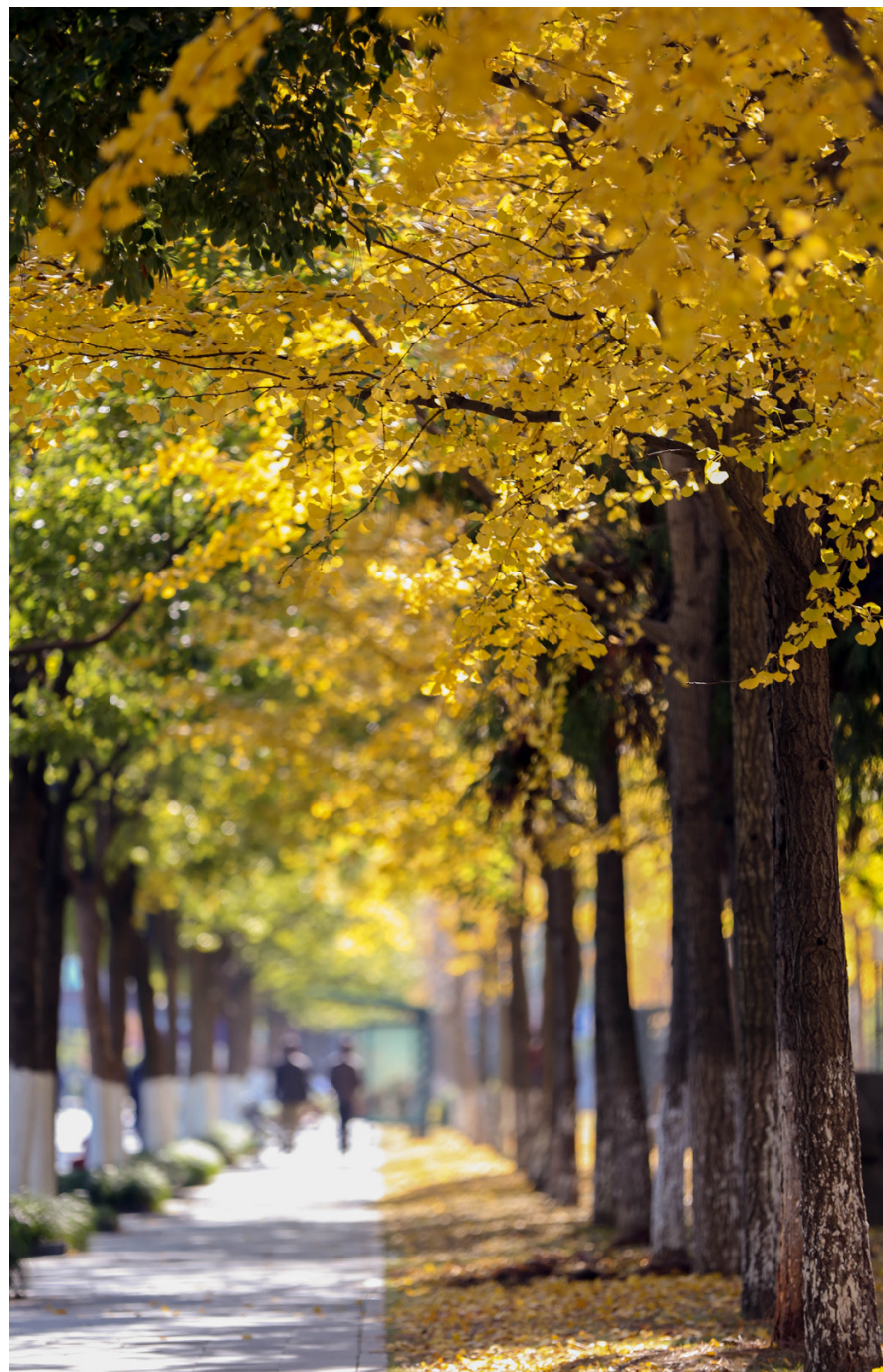
Courses	Course offerings for the new academic year may not be available at the time of application. Course registration for exchange students takes place during registration and orientation week.
Course Load	Zhejiang University follows credit unit system (c.u.). For undergraduates, 2 c.u. is a one quarter course, 3 c.u. course is a full semester.
Restrictions	To be successful at Zhejiang University, students must be proficient in English—both written and verbal. Although we do not require any official record of English proficiency, the home institution should evaluate students' English language proficiency prior to nominating them to Zhejiang University. * No credit requirements for exchange students and please consult home institution for overseas study plan.
Transcripts	To help facilitate transfer credit towards degree, Zhejiang University will release transcript to the student's home institution by email at the beginning of subsequent semester. Hard copies by express mail/courier are available upon request.

HOUSING & INSURANCE

Off Campus	Exchange students living off campus must submit Application Form to the International College and get approval. After signing contract with the owner/agent, you need to go to the local police station for a residence registration.
