Nomination

30th April (Semester 1) | 1st October (Semester 2)

Application

Students must complete an <u>online application</u>, submitting copies of the following supporting documents:

- Official Academic Transcript (English translation if applicable). Unofficial transcripts can be accepted if signed and stamped by the home university.
- Copy of their passport ID page (dual nationals must submit a copy of the passport they will be travelling with.)
- Evidence of English language level, where applicable. For more details check our <u>website</u>.

Applications submitted without ALL supporting documents will not be processed.

Application Deadlines:

31st May (Semester 1) | 31st October (Semester 2)

Academics

Study Load Full year: 120 Exeter credits/60 ECTS

One semester: 60 Exeter credits/30 ECTS

European exchange students must choose 75% of their modules from the department we have the agreement with their home university. International exchange / direct enrol students should take 50% of their modules within one subject area.

Module Restrictions

- Psychology modules are only available for Psychology-specific exchange partners.
- Biomedical Science modules are only available for Biomedical Sciences-specific exchange partners.
- Graduate School of Education, Liberal Arts modules (LIB) and Degree Apprenticeship modules are not available.

Module Availability

Where possible modules will be allocated pre-arrival, but will need to be finalised upon arrival and registration. There is a module change period during the first two weeks of each semester.





Transcripts

Semester 1 transcripts are sent out in March. Full Year and Semester 2 transcripts are sent out in July. A digital version will be sent directly to the home university and student.

Finance

Exchange students are exempt from paying tuition fees. Direct enrol students can find information on tuition fees on the <u>Inbound website</u>.

<u>Living expenses</u> vary depending on lifestyle choices. As a guide, students should budget for approximately £1,136 a month to cover expenses.

Housing

Students cannot apply for university accommodation until their application has been processed. **Full Year at all campuses:** Students are guaranteed housing if they apply by 31st July.

Semester at all campuses: Students are not guaranteed university housing, there are a limited number of rooms available. We recommend that they also research private housing. A list of privately-owned or managed accommodation can be found on the <u>Accommodation webpage</u>.

More semester university accommodation is available in Semester 2.

Immigration

Students who are not British or Irish nationals must enter the UK with the appropriate <u>immigration permission</u>.

- Visitor immigration permission (6 months duration)
- Student Visa (1 year duration)

Students should research which is best for their situation before they submit their application.
