# 1 Course Registration Schedule

[Fall semester courses] (Fall and Winter quarters, normal 15 weeks, and Intensive courses)

<b>Course Registration Period</b>	Sep. 17 <sup>th</sup> 10:00 – Sep. 21 <sup>st</sup> 23:59 * Register for Winter quarter courses during this period as well. * This period is for the WBS courses. For others, please refer to the table below.
<b>Course Cancellation Period</b>	Oct. 6 <sup>th</sup> 10:00 – Oct. 7 <sup>th</sup> 23:59
<b>Winter Quarter Courses Cancellation Period</b>	Dec. 2 <sup>nd</sup> 10:00 – Dec. 3 <sup>rd</sup> 23:59
<b>Intensive Course Registration Period</b>	Jan. 16 <sup>th</sup> 10:00 - Jan. 18 <sup>th</sup> 23:59, 2021
<b>Intensive Course Cancellation Period</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> term: until Feb.1 <sup>st</sup> 12:00, 2021 2 <sup>nd</sup> term: until Feb.9 <sup>th</sup> 12:00, 2021

- 1 You are not allowed the registration after the designated period for any reasons.
- 2 Please confirm the status from “Tentative selection” to “Registration submitted” if you registered on the web page.
- 3 Read and understand well thoroughly and carefully the WBS Bulletin, Guidelines, Course lists, before the registration.
- 5 Please make sure to attend the first class even if the class starts before/during the course registration period.
- 6 Please make sure to confirm your schedule before registering your courses.

### Note on the registering courses offered by the other graduate schools in Waseda

- The schedule and way of registering may be different from WBS.
- Learn more on their web or on the bulletin board of each school office.
- If a WBS course is overlapped with the other school course, in principle, the WBS course will be cancelled, so please be very careful. (It is really critical matter especially for students who are going to register Seminars.)
- There are limits for the other schools, GEC, or CJL courses how many credits can be counted toward graduation. For more details, refer to the next page and the WBS bulletin.

## Notes on the course registration

### ■Upper limits of registration

International MBA and MSc in Finance  
⇒ 11 courses (22 credits) in each semester

### Registration Limit.....

1. Includes credits of the intensive courses for each semester.
2. Includes specialized Research (= credits for seminars and the degree thesis).
3. Excludes non-credit courses and language courses (For IMBA students).
4. Excludes credits obtained as non-degree students before enrollment.
5. Excludes credits obtained at overseas graduate schools during study abroad while enrolled at Waseda.

### ■Regulation for the Taking Courses in Evening Program

- You can NOT take Compulsory Core Courses and Compulsory Elective Courses in the evening programs.

### ■Automatically Registered Courses

The following courses will be registered automatically, so please check the course registration result by logging in 'Login page for course registration period' through MyWaseda:

<International MBA Students>

- Compulsory Core Courses \*1
- Compulsory Elective Core Courses \*1
- Specialized Research Courses \*2

<MSc in Finance Students>

- Compulsory Core Courses \*1
- Research Guidance \*3
- The Degree Thesis \*3

\*1: You will be able to drop these courses during the 1<sup>st</sup> course registration period (not the cancellation period) if you are under any special conditions although we do recommend you to take these courses during the 1<sup>st</sup> year.

\*2: Specialized Research Courses include Seminar, Research Guidance, and the Degree Thesis.

\*3: These courses will be registered automatically from the 2<sup>nd</sup> year. The detailed information will be announced later.

### ■Language Courses for International MBA Program students

If you take Core course as a language course, please submit the copy of the grade report from Grade Report system on the Web' to see you have already taken the core course and the registration form to the WBS office.

## 5 Course Cancellation

- You can cancel courses online.
- You are not allowed to add courses.
- You can cancel WBS courses ONLY.

<b>Cancellation Period *1</b>	<b>Oct. 6<sup>th</sup> 10:00 – Oct. 7<sup>th</sup> 23:59</b>
1. Up to 6 credits (3 courses) can be cancelled ( <u>WBS’s Fall semester (except for Fall Intensive Courses) only</u> ).	
2. If you cancel more than 6 credits (3 courses), the excess credits will be re-registered.	
<b>Cancellation Period for second quarter courses</b>	<b>Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup> 10:00 – Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup> 23:59</b>
1. Up to 2 credits (1 course) can be cancelled ( <u>WBS’s second quarter courses of Fall semester</u> ).	
2. If you cancel more than 2 credits (1 course), the excess credits will be re-registered.	
<b>Cancellation Period for Intensive Courses</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> term: until Feb.1<sup>st</sup> 12:00, 2021</b> <b>2<sup>nd</sup> term: until Feb.9<sup>th</sup> 12:00, 2021</b>
1. Cancellation may be accepted if the reason is unavoidable.	
2. If you want to cancel the course(s), please contact to the WBS office ( <a href="mailto:wbs-ac@list.waseda.jp">wbs-ac@list.waseda.jp</a> )	
3. Excludes from the limit of the cancellation.	

You can NOT undo cancellation online so be very careful. If you should cancel any courses by mistake, contact to the office ASAP during the cancellation period.

### For International MBA students

#### ■Language courses

Students in this program are recommended to take language courses.

Although language course credits are not counted toward graduation, students are recommended to take at least 8 credits. Students who study mainly in English can take Japanese language courses offered by the Center for Japanese Language (hereinafter, CJL), and Students who study mainly in Japanese can take English language courses offered by the Global Education Center (hereinafter, GEC). In addition, students can take Core courses as a language course ( Japanese for those admitted in September, and English for those admitted in April) provided in the MBA Program. Students who take the Core course as a language course may participate in the course for the second time after their regular Core course is completed. Grades in such cases will be given by P/Q assessment. It should be noted that if students take the Japanese courses at CJL for Japanese language or the English courses at GEC , an additional fee will be charged.

\*You can cancel the language course(s) but it is also included in an upper cancellation limit of 6 credits (3 courses).
