Visa :

- Foreign students enrolling in degree programs at NCCU should apply for resident visas with the purpose of study through Taiwan Overseas Representative Offices in order to enter Taiwan (Resident Visa: foreign nationals who intent to stay in Taiwan for more than 180 days should apply for resident visas).
