Specifically, applicants are requested to possess twelve or more published research papers/articles in either English or Japanese in addition to the doctoral dissertation. Of these published research papers/articles, three or more must be published in highly reputed, peer-reviewed academic journals. A single-authored book based on one's original research will be considered as four research papers/articles. Please note that research papers/articles as well as academic books which have not been published yet but have already been accepted for publication will be considered as published materials if the publication process can be certified. All other things being equal, preference will be given to those who possess the research papers/articles in both English and Japanese.

(Associate Professor)

The candidate must have sufficient quality and quantity of academic achievements to provide project research seminar/guidance in the PhD Program. Specifically, applicants are requested to possess seven or more published research papers/articles in either English or Japanese in addition to the doctoral dissertation. Of these published research papers/articles, three or more must be published in highly reputed, peer-reviewed academic journals. A single-authored book based on one's original research will be considered as four research papers/articles. Please note that research papers/articles as well as academic books which have not been published yet but have already been accepted for publication will be considered as published materials if the publication process can be certified. All other things being equal, preference will be given to those who possess the research papers/articles in both English and Japanese.
