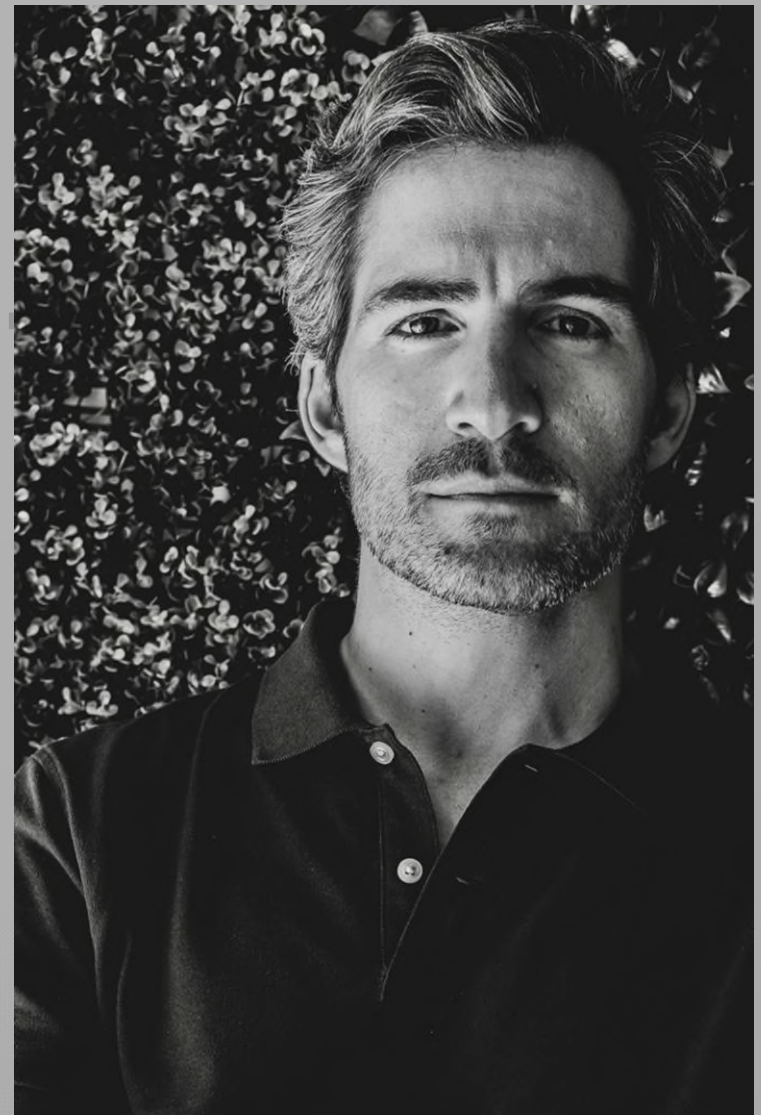


The future of the Japan-South Korea Joint Development Agreement (1978-2028)

Professor Vasco Becker-Weinberg is a professor at the Faculty of Law of the Universidade Lusófona, teaching Constitutional Law, Public International Law and EU Law. He has researched at prominent academic institutions and written and published extensively on the Law of the Sea, including *Joint development of hydrocarbon deposits in the law of the sea* (Springer, 2014). He is the founder and president of IPDM–The Portuguese Institute of the Law of the Sea (www.ipdm.pt) and the Editor-in-Chief of the Portuguese Yearbook of the Law of the Sea.



When the Japan-South Korea Joint Development Agreement was signed in 1974, it was regarded as a joint development model based on the corporation of coastal States with overlapping claims. However, the agreement has not produced any oil and gas since it entered into force in 1978, and will be expired in 2028. The speaker will provide insight into the future of the agreement.
