FAQs

- **Q1.** Do you accept students of any nationalities? If not, who are not eligible?
- A1. Yes, but Thai nationals are not allowed to apply.
- **Q2.** Will exchange students allowed and able to take courses offered by other schools at the University?
- A2. Yes, they can take 1-2 courses offered by other schools at the university.
- **Q3.** Are there any academic requirements for MA exchange students while at the University? (e.g. Exchange students are required to take X number of courses.)
- A3. They are required to enroll in at least 1 course up to 4 courses (12 credits) of the MIR Program that includes the total subject of outside school.
- **Q4.** Are there any academic requirements for Ph.D. students while at the University?
- A4. No.
- **Q5.** Are there any additional application documents to be submitted if the applicant is Ph.D. student?
- A5. Research proposal
- **Q6.** Will exchange students be able to take local language classes free of charge at the university?
- A6. Yes, it includes the course offered by other school; as an example, Beginning Thai course of Thai Studies Program.
- **Q7.** Do you accept a TOEIC score as a certificate of English language proficiency?
- A7. No.
- **Q8.** Will students with an academic degree from at an institution in an English speaking country beexempted from submitting a certificate of English language proficiency?
- A8. Yes, they will.
- **Q9.** Are there any requirements/regulations at the University exchange program applicants should beparticularly aware of?
- A9. Yes, international travelers should concern about the Measurements of the Royal Thai Government for Entry to Thailand and the announcement of Thammasat University on the COVID-19 prevention.
- **Q10.** Will exchange students be able to do internship at a company or international organization during the semester exchange program? If so, are there any application procedures to take at the university?
- A10. Yes, and there are not any application procedures to take at the university.
- **Q11.** If exchange students intend to observe or collect data for research paper, should the home institute coordinator and student need to contact that office/people before arriving?
- A11. Yes, students need to find out the procedures of submission and regarding the organized documents on their own.
