for students who enrolled in September 2025

Student Health Check-up will be conducted as follows. Eligible students are required to take the health check-up every year (from next year, make sure to take the regular health check-up in April).

The health check-up has two purposes. Firstly, it is for your health maintenance and prevention/early detection of diseases. Secondly, it's to prevent the spread of infectious diseases such as Tuberculosis on campus.

1. Eligible students

- (1) Regular students who enrolled in undergraduate school or graduate school in September 2025.
- (2) Students who received a notice of Health Check-up from the undergraduate/graduate school office of your affiliation.
- (3) Students who received a notice of Health Check-up from CIE*

4. Contents of the health check-up

- (1) Inspection items
 - Health Survey (Completed in advance on the web and the day of the health check-up, if necessary).
 - 2 Physical measurements (Height and weight), Eyesight, Blood pressure, Urine analysis, Doctor's examination, Chest X-ray (available only for new students and students who have been instructed by the Health Support Center)
- (2) Time required(approximate) about 1 hour *It may differ depending on the date/time.
- (3) What to bring
 - ① Student ID card
 - *Contact your school office on when/how to obtain the Student ID card.
 - 2 Urine sample: Collect your urine before coming to the venue.
 - You may pick up the urine sampling devices at the Health Care Room, Nishi-Waseda Branch, or Toyama Branch in advance.
 - *If you do not take a urine sample in advance, you can collect it at the venue. However, it will delay the end of the health check-up.
 - ③ Something that confirms your reservation: Any screenshot or pre-printed reservation confirmation e-mail, My Page on the reservation site, or reminder e-mail.
 - Black ballpoint pen: Used to fill out additionally the Health Survey. (Erasable ballpoint pens are not allowed)
 - ⑤ Plain T-shirt (Only for those eligible for chest X-ray)
 - 6 Confirmation of having undergone the Health Check-up and ECG test

(On-campus athletic facilities for those who wish to use them)

Regarding the use of on-campus athletic facilities (Training Center, Takaishi Memorial Pool, Aqua Arena

If you wish to register or renew to use on-campus athletic facilities before the results become available on MyWASEDA (around mid-November), please print out "Confirmation of having undergone the Health Check-up and ECG test" in advance and submit it at the reception on the day of your health check-up. Forms are also available at the reception desk of each on-campus athletic facility.

- *1 Be sure to fill in your student ID number and name in advance.
- *2 If you forget to bring the form on the day of your health checkup, you should wait to register on-campus athletic facilities until your result is available on MyWASEDA. We will not make any exceptions.
- *3 Printing the forms is not possible at the venue.

Notes

- Please wear clothes that are easy to take off and put on, such as plain T-shirts.
 What to wear for the Health Check-up
- Chest x-rays are taken in the X-ray car. When preparing for the examination, several people may change their clothes in the car. If you have any questions about the X-ray car, please contact the Health Care Room between September 22 and September 29.
- The medical examinations will be conducted in the order of the available booths. If you need a doctor's gender consideration, please inform the health check-up staff at the venue.
- The above schedule will be the last health check-up to be conducted at the University in AY2025.
