Prior to the current appointment, he served as Vice President for Latin America and the Caribbean, Division Director for Eritrea, Kenya, Rwanda, Somalia and Uganda based in Nairobi, the senior director of the World Bank Group's Macroeconomics, Trade and Investment Global Practice (MTI). Before joining the Bank, Jaramillo was a public servant in the Government of Colombia, holding offices in the Ministry of Finance, the Central Bank and the Ministry of Trade. He holds an M.A. and a Ph. D. in development economics from Stanford University.
