


Q1. Please evaluate how well-organized the EAUI Summer School 2025 was.




Q2. Please evaluate how reasonable the overall scheduling of the EAUI Summer School 2025 was over the course of the 5-day program.



Q3. Please evaluate how well-balanced and effective the format of the EAUI Summer School 2025 , which combined lectures, field trip, symposium, and student presentations was.







Q6. Please evaluate how much the field trip contributed to new discoveries and learning for you.






