The Graduate School of Asia-Pacific Studies at WASEDA University is conducting an academic recruitment for the following full-time academic faculty position:

1. Fields of Expertise

“International relations of Asia-Pacific region”

April 1, 2027 (or a later date that can be agreed upon)

5. Status Upon Employment

Professor or Associate Professor (tenured positions)

6. Expected responsibilities

1. Teaching multiple courses related to “1. Fields of “Expertise” and supervising MA and Ph.D. students
2. Educational and research activities at the Graduate School of Asia-Pacific Studies (GSAPS) and the Waseda Institute of Asia-Pacific Studies (WIAPS)
3. Services associated with the operation of the University, GSAPS and WIAPS

7. Benefits

- 1. Duty hours:** Scheduled working days and working hours (when you start/finish, rest periods) are based on the university regulations. The discretionary labor system for professional work (working hours will be deemed as 8 hours per day) will be applied to research work. Working hours and the way to proceed with work are at the discretion of faculty.
- 2. Salary, Benefits and Commutation Expenses:** in accordance with Waseda university Regulations

5. Holidays: Saturdays, Sundays, the end and the beginning of the year, National Holidays, compensatory holidays appointed by Waseda University for holding classes on public holidays, and University Anniversaries (excluding days specified by the university on which classes are held).

6. Vacations: Vacations determined in acts such as Labor Standard Acts and Vacations determined by the university.

7. Retirement age: 70 years old

8. Qualifications

1. In principle, the candidate should hold a doctoral degree at the time of application.
2. The candidate must have sufficient research and educational experiences and achievements to provide project research seminar/guidance and lectures in both Master (MA) and PhD Programs of GSAPS.
3. (Professor)

The candidate must have sufficient quality and quantity of academic achievements to provide project research seminar/guidance in the PhD Program. We expect applicants to have at least twelve or more published research papers/articles in either English or Japanese in addition to the doctoral dissertation. Of these published research papers/articles, three or more must be published in highly reputed, peer-reviewed academic journals. A single-authored book based on one's original research will be considered as four research papers/articles. Please note that research papers/articles as well as academic books which have not been published yet but have already been accepted for publication will be considered as published materials if the publication process can be certified. All other things being equal, preference will be given to those who possess the research papers/articles in both English and Japanese.

(Associate Professor)

The candidate must have sufficient quality and quantity of academic achievements to provide project research seminar/guidance in the PhD Program. We expect applicants to have at least seven or more published research papers/articles in either English or

Japanese in addition to the doctoral dissertation. Of these published research papers/articles, three or more must be published in highly reputed, peer-reviewed academic journals. A single-authored book based on one's original research will be considered as four research papers/articles. Please note that research papers/articles as well as academic books which have not been published yet but have already been accepted for publication will be considered as published materials if the publication process can be certified. All other things being equal, preference will be given to those who possess the research papers/articles in both English and Japanese.

* Position upon employment will be decided during the screening.

4. The candidate must have a proven track record in obtaining competitive external research funding, such as the Grants in Aid for Scientific Research by the Japanese government or equivalent distinguished professional grants.
5. The candidate should be able to conduct lectures and seminars fluently in both English and Japanese. Please note that this may be exempted in the case of those who possess particularly distinguished research achievements or professional experience.
6. The candidate must be able to engage in the required administrative positions and duties at GSAPS, WIAPS, and other departments at Waseda University.
7. The candidate must be able to contribute to the research and educational activities of GSAPS and WIAPS at Waseda University.

9. Application Documents

Based in particular on the qualifications listed in section 8 (above), please specify how you believe that you can contribute to GSAPS. Please include actual course names that you will be able to teach based on your field(s) of specialization in the essay. Please do not exceed 800 words in English or 2,000 characters in Japanese.

Please supply a current CV using the official Waseda University CV application form, and please attach a recent photograph. You need to specify your email address.

3) List of Academic Achievements: List your education research achievements using the official Waseda University format (“Education and Research Achievement”)

11. Selection Process

-First Screening – Application document screening

-Second Screening – For applicants who pass the first screening. The second screening will consist of a presentation of applicant’s research, a mock lecture, a Q&A session, and an interview, including a light meal, with the faculty members of the GSAPS.

*The second screening will be held in-person at Waseda University (Waseda Campus) on **June 28 (Sun), July 4 (Sat), or July 5 (Sun), 2026 (tentative).**

*The second screening is expected to take roughly half a day.

*Travel expenses to and from the Waseda Campus of Waseda University and accommodation expenses, if necessary, for the second screening will be provided by Waseda University according to University rules.

*Expenses for the meals during the interview for second screening will be paid by

Waseda University according to University guidelines.

*Other expenses, not mentioned above, shall be covered by the applicant.

*The conditions of the travel/accommodation expenses and the details of the second screening will be provided to applicants who pass the first screening.
