Dr. Daniel Joyce is an Associate Professor and Dean (Research) at UNSW Law & Justice. His research expertise spans international law, media law, and human rights. This special lecture features the author of *Informed Publics, Media and International Law* (Hart Publishing, 2020), to mark the publication of its Japanese translation (supervised by Yota Negishi, translated by Koichi Inamori and Akio Hanada, Horitsu Bunka Sha, 2026).

Dr. Joyce will present his latest research.
