 - **Nomination Deadline:** September 15th, 2026
 - **Application Deadline:** October 15th, 2026
- **Requirements**
 - **Language:** TOEFL iBT 80 / IELTS 6.5 / TOEIC 800
 - **GPA:** Minimum 2.0 (on 4.0 scale)
 - **Documents:** Application Form (After nomination), Nomination Certificate, Enrollment Certificate, Official Transcript, Study Plan.

Visa & Entry Information

- **Visa Application:** Even if your passport allows visa-free entry, exchange students are expected to apply for a proper visa for their studies.
- **Visa Types:**
 - Stay < 180 days: Apply for a Visitor Visa.
 - Stay > 180 days: Apply for a Resident Visa.
- Please consider your travel plans for re-entering Taiwan when choosing a single-entry or multiple-entry visa.

Health Examination Information

- **Mandatory Requirement:** All exchange students must complete a health check.
 - **Option A (In Home Country):** Complete the exam before arrival. You must provide official proof of MMR (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) vaccination and a Chest X-ray report.
 - **Option B (In Taiwan):** Join the on-campus group health exam (typically held in late August, e.g., August 30th).
