## [GSICCS 2023 April Enrollment Admissions] Measures in Response to COVID-19

In the face of the COVID-19 pandemic, GSICCS has decided to take the following measures for 2023 April enrollment admission applicants.

## **English Proficiency Test Accommodations**

As a rule, applicants are required to submit the scores of the designated tests <u>taken</u> <u>at a test center</u>. However, given the complex situations under the COVID-19 pandemic, GSICCS will accept the following test scores <u>ONLY IF access to a testing</u> <u>site is not available due to COVID-19</u>;

- TOEFL(iBT) Home Edition
- TOEFL(iBT) Paper Edition
- Duolingo English Test

<Master's Program Applicants who completed an undergraduate or graduate program conducted in English>

- GRE General Test at Home
- LSAT-Flex
- GMAT Online Exam

## <Doctoral Program Applicants>

- GRE General Test at Home
- Test scores should be directly sent to the GSICCS Admissions office.
   Detailed submission methods will be explained in the Application Guidelines.
- Applicants who submit the above test scores are requested to explain the reason
  on the designated online application system. They are also required to upload
  proof for the reasons why they were not able to access the testing site (e.g.
  screenshot of an e-mail regarding the cancellation of test, medical certificate to
  prove that the applicant could not take the test due to the infection etc.) .
  Detailed instructions will be given in the Application Guidelines.

Please kindly note that the measures mentioned above are in effect as of May 20, 2022. The GSICCS Admissions Office will continue to carefully observe the influence of the pandemic and may take additional measures.
