F+	Fail	No representation on transcripts	Considering attendance, test results, and reports, the student deserves to take a re-test.	Yes
F			Considering attendance, test results, and reports, the student does not deserve to take a re-test.	No

※The formula of the School of International Liberal Studies to calculate your AAA (Academic Achievement Average) is as follows:

$$\frac{\{(4.0 \times A+ \text{ and } A \text{ credits}) + (3.0 \times B \text{ credits}) + (2.0 \times C \text{ credits})\}}{\text{Total number of credits}}$$

A+, A, B, C specified on transcripts will be respectively converted into 4, 4, 3, 2. F+ and F specified on report cards will not be taken into account. However, please note that there is a possibility that the formula can be changed in the future.
