The School of International Liberal Studies has its own grading criteria called **AAA (Academic Achievement Average)**. It is used for the evaluation of academic probation, early graduation, and so on. SILS does not have a GPA system.

※The formula to calculate your **AAA (Academic Achievement Average)** is as follows:

$$\frac{\{(4.0 \times A+ \text{ and } A \text{ credits}) + (3.0 \times B \text{ credits}) + (2.0 \times C \text{ credits})\}}{\text{Total number of credits (excluding "N" accredited credits and voluntary courses)}}$$

A+, A, B, C will be respectively converted into 4, 4, 3, 2. F, G, and N (accredited) specified on grade reports and voluntary courses will not be taken into account. However, please note that there is a possibility that the formula can be changed in the future.
