- Those who graduated (are graduating) from International Schools and 外国人学校 in Japan are NOT applicable.
- Those who hold the Japanese nationality, or 'Permanent' visa, 'Long-term resident' visa, 'Spouse or Child of Japanese' visa holders.
- The latest annual income of parent(s) proved on the income certificate must be:

- Those who hold the Japanese nationality, or 'Permanent' visa, 'Long-term resident' visa, 'Spouse or Child of Japanese' visa holders.
- The latest annual income of parent(s) proved on the income certificate must be:
