【SILS 2027 September Admission Onwards】

Change in Exemption Requirements for Submission of English Proficiency Test Score for AO April (Overseas) and September Admission

Effective 2027 September admission, the School of International Liberal Studies will change the exemption requirements for submission of English proficiency test scores as follows.

Exemption Requirements for Submission of English Proficiency Test Scores

Current Requirement	From AO 2027 September Admission
If you submit a standardized test administered for an educational system where the first language is English, such as SAT, ACT, GCE A-level, or IB entirely taught in English etc., it is optional for you to submit English Language Proficiency Test Score.	The submission of English proficiency test scores is exempted (or optional) only for applicants who will have studied full-time at least three of the most recent four years, by the time of enrollment at Waseda University, in a high school, college, or university where the sole language of instruction is English except for foreign language classes.
