If you have the results, upload a PDF version of "Verification Report of China High School Academic Proficiency Test (Huikao) Results" issued in English by CSSD (学信网). Verification Report must include your legal name in alphabet and verification QR code. Only report issued by CSSD will be considered valid. Huikao results are used only for the purpose of reviewing applicants' eligibility.

If you will sit/sat for the test, you will be asked to send English version of "Verification Report of China Secondary Education Qualification Certificate (中国中等教育学历验证报告 issued in English)" (not the Huikao results) directly from CSSD (学信网) as a part of our enrollment procedures. In addition, you may also be required to send English version of "Verification Report of China High School Academic Proficiency Test (Huikao) Results" directly from CSSD (学信网).
