

**【JCulP Overseas Students】**

**Minimum Score of an English Language Proficiency Test for 2020 enrollment**

In Global Studies in Japanese Cultures Program (JCulP)overseas students admission, the applicants who don't submit a certificate of university entrance qualification examinations / standardized tests administered for an educational system in which the first language is English (such as SAT, ACT[The American College Testing Program], GCE, IB taught in English, etc.) are required to submit the Score of an English Language Proficiency Test. **From screening for 2020 enrollment, JCulP sets the minimum Score of an English Language Proficiency Test required for application.**

(If you submit a certificate of university entrance qualification examinations / standardized tests administered for an educational system in which the first language is English , you are considered as meeting the score requirements shown below.)

If you are the applicant required to submit English Language Proficiency Test Score and if your score doesn't meet the requirements below, you fail in the screening for JCulP admission (Your other documents won't be screened).

- You should choose one from four tests above(the score of other tests is not acceptable).
- Go back from the Application Period, the score taken around within two years will be valid. For details, please refer to the Application Guidelines for JCulP which will be released on this web site by late September. Also, regarding other application documents, please refer to the Application Guidelines for JCulP.
- There is no bonus point even if you submit considerably higher score than the standards shown above. Also, there is no advantage or disadvantage depends on test type.

• The minimum score shown above is for September 2020 enrollment. After 2020, there is a possibility that the standards are changed.
