You need at least 124 credits to graduate.

You must register for the designated credits in each Course Category. (see "Student Handbook" p.18)

1. Coursework Overview

- To be promoted to the second year, you must earn at least 28 of the 124 credits required to graduate.
- Among these 28 credits, you need:

Required Core Seminars: 2 credits

Elective English (Required): 6 credits



Fall semester of your 1st year

- Maximum number of credits: 22
- 12 required credits will be automatically registered.

You do not need to register for these manually.

- Intensive Studies 9 (Survey of Japanese Literature 1)
- Intensive Studies 12 (Intro to Japanese Culture & Civ 1)

Winter quarter

- Intensive Studies 10 (Survey of Japanese Literature 2)
- Intensive Studies 13 (Intro to Japanese Culture & Civ 2)

Fall semester of your 1st year

You must register for classes scheduled in

- Fall quarter (September 2020-November 2020)
- Winter quarter (November 2020-January 2021)
- Fall semester (September 2020-January 2021)



Spring semester of your 1st year

- Maximum number of credits: 22
- 4 required credits will be automatically registered.

You do not need to register for these manually.

Spring quarter

- Intensive Studies 11 (Survey of Japanese Literature 3)
- Intensive Studies 14 (Intro to Japanese Culture & Civ 3)



Spring semester of your 1st year

            (22 cr. max - 4 cr. required = 18 cr.)
            Other Elective English classes
            Lectures
            Japanese Language Courses etc.

2. Course Registration Spring semester of your 1st year

You must register for classes scheduled in

- Spring quarter (April 2021-May 2021)
- Summer quarter (June 2021-July 2021)
- Spring semester (April 2021-July 2021)



The maximum number of credits you can register for in your 1^{st} year is 42!

22 (Fall) + 22 (Spring) = 44

It is recommended that you register for courses appropriate for your Japanese level, but it is possible to register for courses at a higher or lower level, if you wish.



You need at least **24 credits of Japanese**Language courses to graduate.

If you are already proficient in Japanese, you can ask for an exemption, but <u>you will still have to earn</u> those 24 credits through other courses.

See the handout "日本語科目履修免除方法について" for information on how to apply for the exemption.



Steps to get your exemption:

- 1.**TODAY**, make an appointment for an interview by emailing Prof. Pitarch at pitarch@waseda.jp
- 2. Take the Japanese Level Check Test (CJL)
- 3. Score level 6 or better, and print out the score report
- 4. Submit the score report to the Administrative Office ASAP (In person, or email a scan to toyama-kamoku@list.waseda.jp)
