Change in the Standardized Test Requirements from Canadian Education Systems: Global Studies in Japanese Cultures Program (JCulP) Overseas Students Admissions (from 2027 Intake Onwards)

Beginning with the 2027 JCulP Overseas Students Admissions, the School of Culture, Media and Society will no longer accept academic transcripts as standardized test results from graduates from Canadian education systems.

Instead, these students will be required to submit the results of SAT or ACT scores as standardized test results.
