## **Attention Fourth-year or above Undergraduate Students of JCulP OS!**

### **Announcement of Screening Result of Status for Graduation and Status for Expected Acquisition of Teaching License**

Screening results regarding the status for graduation in March/September 2026 and expected acquisition of teaching license for fourth-year and above undergraduate students will be announced on the following date on the Grade Report of MyWaseda.

**9:00 am Tuesday, October 28, 2025**

The “Status for Graduation” is granted to students who are expected to satisfy the requirements for graduation in March/September 2026 based on the credits acquired up to the spring semester and the courses they have registered for in the fall semester. The judgment on the status for graduation in fall semesters is made based on the assumptions that the student passes all the courses they have registered for in the fall semester and that registration is properly made with no missing subjects in the spring semester. **Even if you have the “Status for Graduation” as of the fall semester, your status may be “Impossible Status for Graduation” according to the judgment made for the spring semester if, for example, you fail any of the subjects taken in the fall semester, you failed to enroll in a required subject offered only in fall semesters, or you failed to properly register your courses in the spring semester.**

**Starting from Monday, November 10, prospective graduates can obtain Certificates of Expected Graduation (certificates won’t be issued earlier under any circumstances).**

**Also, for students who enroll beyond 4 years, please note that “Certificate of Expected Graduation” cannot be issued from October 16 (Thu.) to November 9 (Sun.) due to the above-mentioned judgment.**

Judgment regarding the expected acquisition of teaching license are made for students who are already registered for the Induction Program for Teaching Practice (教育実習) in the 2025 academic year or who have already obtained credits from the seminar earlier. Such a judgment is based on subjects for the Teaching Methods (教科教育法) course for which students already have acquired credits or have registered.

If you expect to graduate or obtain a teaching license in March/September 2026, but your status does not show that, there may be a problem related to the credits you have acquired up to the spring semester or course registration for this fall semester. **Please come or send an email to the Administrative Office of the Faculty of Letters, Arts and Sciences by 16:00 JST on Wednesday, October 29.**
