**Announcement of Screening Result of Status for Graduation**

Screening results regarding the status for graduation in September 2026 for fourth-year and above JCulP OS students will be announced on the following date on the Grade Report of MyWaseda.

**After 9:00 am Tuesday, May 12, 2026**

The “Status for Graduation” is granted to students who are expected to satisfy the requirements for graduation in September 2026 based on the credits acquired up to the previous semester and the courses they have registered for in this spring semester. The screening results regarding the status for graduation in the previous semester was made based on the assumptions that the students would pass all the courses they have registered for in the spring semester. **Even if you have the “Status for Graduation” as of the previous semester, your status may be “Impossible Status for Graduation” according to the judgment made for the spring semester if, for example, you failed any of the subjects taken in the fall semester, or you failed to properly register your courses in the spring semester.**

Please note that **“Certificates of Expected Graduation” cannot be issued from April 24 to June 1 AM due** to this screening.

If you expect to graduate in September 2026, but your status is “Impossible Status for Graduation”, there may be a problem related to the credits you have acquired up to the fall semester or course registration for this spring semester. **Please come or send an email to the Administrative Office of the Faculty of Letters, Arts and Sciences by 16:00 JST on Wednesday, May 13.** (\* Email address: [toyama-seiseki@list.waseda.jp](mailto:toyama-seiseki@list.waseda.jp). No requests via phone calls will be accepted.)
