We use the Zoom meeting. The applicants must prepare their own usage environment.

Before the actual online interview, please test your internet connection by joining a test meeting

(<https://zoom.us/test>).

➤ Internet connection

You are responsible for preparing a stable Internet connection. To ensure a stable connection, we strongly recommend that you connect to a wired LAN via a cable rather than a wireless LAN (e.g., Wi-Fi). Please be aware that the university cannot be held responsible for any technical or network trouble occurring during the online interview.

➤ Audio/ Visual Equipment

You will need a webcam and a microphone to use the system. You can use a built-in webcam on your computer.

➤ Location

As well as preparing the above environment, you must prepare a room where you can ensure that no third parties will enter.

Please ensure to prepare an environment where you can have an interview without any disturbances.
