

AY2021 Tuition for Extended Study Students

The tuition charged for extended study students*is calculated based on the number of credits still required in order to meet the completion requirements as of the end of the preceding semester, and review of master thesis.

*“extended study students” means the students who have been enrolled in the master program at the Graduate School of Letters, Arts and Sciences for more than two years. The number of years of enrollment does NOT include period of Leave of Absence and period of study abroad (excluding some programs).

Any extended study students who will be studying overseas on an exchange program need to pay the regular amount of tuition irrespective of the number of credits that they still need to earn in order to graduate.

[Information only for students who enrolled in or after AY2017]

Tuition fee for students who meet both of the following requirements will be 50% of the regular amount of tuition.

- Students who have become extended study students after studying overseas for one semester or longer, and
- Students whose number of credits still required is 14 or fewer.

However, regulation above will be applied for one year (two semesters) at the longest. "Study overseas" written above does NOT include short-term program and leave of absence.

Tuition for the Fall Semester: December 1st
(Letter/notice for bank transfer will be sent in the end of November)
