Professor John Jowett:

Prof. John Jowett is Emeritus Professor of Shakespeare Studies and former Deputy Director at the Shakespeare Institute, University of Birmingham. He is a general editor of the digital and print New Oxford Shakespeare *Complete Works* (2016-17), in which he was lead general editor of the Critical Reference Edition and editor of challenging plays such as *Hamlet* and *King Lear*. He also general edits the Arden Early Modern Drama series of Renaissance plays written by authors other than Shakespeare. Previously,



he was an associate general editor of the prizewinning Oxford *Collected Works* of Thomas Middleton (2007). He has prepared acclaimed editions of *Richard III* and *Timon of Athens* for the Oxford World's Classics series, and of *Sir Thomas More* for the Arden Shakespeare. He is a leading authority in the field of textual studies, he has published in areas ranging from book history to Shakespeare criticism, and he is author of *Shakespeare and Text* (2007, revised

edition 2019). His project on Sir Edward Dering's 1623 adaptation of Shakespeare's Henry IV plays is published as a mini-website by the Folger Shakespeare Library. Currently he is editing Ben Jonson's *Volpone* for Arden Early Modern Drama.
