## Announcement of Screening Result of Status for Completion

Screening results regarding the status for completion in March 2026 (September 2025 in the case of students subject to complete in September) for second-year and above graduate students will be announced on the following date on the Grade Report of MyWaseda.

## After 9:00 am Monday, May 12, 2025

The "Status for Completion" is granted to students who are expected to satisfy the requirements for completion in March 2026 (September 2025 in the case of students subject to complete in September) based on the credits acquired up to the previous year and the courses they have registered for this year.

The judgment on the status for completion might be changed to "Impossible Status for Completion" in the fall semester, if students fail any of the subjects taken in the spring semester, however, screening will not be made again in the fall semester.

This Screening is made based on number of credits for the required subjects. The required research seminar and master's thesis are not considered in this Screening. Furthermore, for those who applied for credits earned before admission, the number of those credits are not considered.

Starting from Monday, June 2 Tuesday, June 3 PM (\* The change was made due to maintenance of the certificate issuance service), prospective graduates (including those expected to complete in September) can request Certificates of Expected Completion via MyWaseda (certificates won't be issued earlier under any circumstances).

Please note that <u>"Certificates of Expected Graduation" can not be issued from April 25 to June 1</u> June 3 AM due to this screening.

If you expect to complete in March 2026 (September 2025 in the case of students subject to complete in September), but your status is "Impossible Status for Completion", there may be a problem related to the credits you have acquired up to the previous semester or course registration for this spring semester. **Please come or send an email to the Administrative Office of the Faculty of Letters, Arts and Sciences by 16:00 JST on Tuesday, May 13.** (\* Email address: toyama-seiseki@list.waseda.jp.
