

# Lectionary Production in the Scriptorium of Chalkoprateia

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## Abstract

This paper examines the possibility of the hypothesis that a scriptorium existed in the Church of St. Mary of Chalkoprateia in Constantinople, the capital of the Byzantine Empire, during the late eleventh and twelfth centuries. Among the lectionary manuscripts that the author has examined so far, 36 contain the *encaenia* (dedication feast of a church/monastery) of Chalkoprateia. There are two theoretical reasons for this phenomenon: 1. Chalkoprateia ordered the lectionaries for use in the church; 2. Chalkoprateia had a scriptorium, and the lectionaries produced there bear Chalkoprateia's *encaenia* instead of the signature. It is unlikely, however, that 36 manuscripts were used in one church in such a short period of time, and the author believes that a scriptorium existed in Chalkoprateia. A comparative study of the *menologion* of 36 manuscripts confirmed that it was not significantly different from the calendar of the Patriarchate. Since the Chalkoprateia and the Patriarchate are adjacent, it is not surprising that their liturgies are almost identical. Table 3 is the expected version of the saints' calendar used in the scriptorium of Chalkoprateia, and any deviations from this are presumed to be at the request of the patron of the manuscript.

The research on Byzantine scriptoria<sup>(1)</sup> has been primarily based on colophons; as auxiliary means, on paleographical and codicological evidence and occasionally the style of miniatures<sup>(2)</sup>. In this article, I utilize a new method to demonstrate that the Church of St. Mary of Chalkoprateia in Constantinople<sup>(3)</sup> had a scriptorium, which was a prolific producer of lectionaries (including *Evangelia*, Gospel lectionary, and *Praxapostolos*, lectionary of Acts and Epistles) in the eleventh and twelfth centuries, although the existence of the scriptorium in Chalkoprateia has not been proven by written documents yet.

## *Encaenia of Chalkoprateia*

In my previous articles<sup>(4)</sup>, I emphasized the importance of *encaenia* (ἐγκαίνια, dedication feast of churches or monasteries) for studies on lectionary manuscripts<sup>(5)</sup>. The Patriarchal lectionaries<sup>(6)</sup> produced in the second half of the eleventh century include the following characteristic *encaenia*: Chapel of Theotokos in the Patriarchate (31 Oct.)<sup>(7)</sup>; St. Theodore *en tois Sphorakiou* (5 Nov.); Church of the Palace (1 Dec.); Church of Chalkoprateia (18 Dec.); Nea Ekklesia (1 May), in addition to the usual *encaenia* that many other manuscripts also adopt: Church of Christ's Anastasis in Jerusalem (13 Sep.); Hagia Sophia (*Megale Ekklesia*) in Constantinople (*anoixia* 22 Dec., *encaenia* 23 Dec.). It can be inferred from the *encaenia* that these churches were then under the direct jurisdiction of the Patriarchate.

While the Patriarchal lectionaries have distinctive *encaenia*, there are other manuscripts that contain *encaenia* on the principal churches of the Capital (**Table 1**). The number of manuscripts with the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia is overwhelmingly large (36)<sup>(8)</sup>, as far as my present investigation is concerned<sup>(9)</sup>. Of these, 11 manuscripts also include the *encaenia* of the Sphorakiou Church, 16 of the Pege Church, and only one manuscript shares the *encaenia* of both Sphorakiou and Pege. The two types of the *encaenia* pattern, Chalkoprateia- Sphorakiou and Chalkoprateia- Pege, tend not to overlap in principle.

To analyze from the opposite side, namely from the side of Pege and Sphorakiou, 20 manuscripts adopt the *encaenia* of the Pege Church, 16 of which contain the Chalkoprateia *encaenia*; 13 manuscripts include the *encaenia* of the Sphorakiou Church, 11 of which contain the Chalkoprateia *encaenia*. Both the Pege and Sphorakiou Churches seem to be subordinate to Chalkoprateia. On the overlapping relationship of the *encaenia*, see **Table 2**.

There are 14 manuscripts with the *encaenia* of Nea Ekklesia, 12 of which have no other *encaenia*, while two manuscripts share the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia and Sphorakiou. Nine manuscripts have the *encaenia* of the Blachernais Church, eight of which have no other *encaenia*, while one manuscript shares the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia and Sphorakiou. Accordingly, Nea Ekklesia and the Blachernais Church is not subordinate to other churches, but independent.

In the case of the Patriarchal lectionaries, the selection of *encaenia* was dictated by the patron of the manuscripts, namely by the Patriarchate, and nothing is known about their scriptorium. Then, what about the 36 manuscripts with Chalkoprateia *encaenia*? It is not likely that the Chalkoprateia Church ordered and used the 36 lectionaries, four times the number of the Patriarchal lectionaries, in a limited period of time. A possible hypothesis in this case would be that Chalkoprateia did not order the manuscripts, but produced them, that is, in the scriptorium. The scribe would have added the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia to the calendar, without the means of a colophon, to indicate that the manuscript was made by Chalkoprateia.

To evaluate this hypothesis, I statistically analyze the calendars of the saints (immovable feasts, *Menologion*) in the 36 manuscripts. If these lectionaries were produced in the same scriptorium, they would most likely adopt the same calendar; however, it is also conceivable that different calendars may be required depending on the wishes of the entity ordering the manuscript. As a result, the calendars of the 36 manuscripts essentially coincided; this hypothetical calendar of Chalkoprateia does not differ significantly from the Patriarchal one<sup>(10)</sup>, and can be called a simplified version of it (**Table 3**). The Chalkoprateia Church, under the jurisdiction of the Patriarchate, is in its immediate neighborhood; it is unnatural to imagine that the two held completely separate rites. However, the calendars of both exhibit differences in some respects. Our state of research is not at the stage of comparative analysis of the calendars of the various churches and monasteries.

Despite the 36 manuscripts with the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia suggest the existence of its scriptorium, it is also evident that not all 36 manuscripts were produced in the Chalkoprateia Scriptorium. For example, the **MSS Z** and **a** (see the **List of Manuscripts** below) are more closely associated with the Patriarchate than the Chalkoprateia Church, because the **MS Z** follows almost exactly the calendar of the recension of Cod.Paris.gr.286, and the **MS a** follows that of the recension of Venice, Istituto Ellenico, gr.2<sup>(11)</sup>. Of the 36 manuscripts, the **MS j**, with full-page Evangelists' portraits and luxurious headpieces, deviates from the standard calendar of Chalkoprateia in 149 days of the year, even though 12 May through 31 Aug. are lacking; this is followed by the **MS A**<sup>(12)</sup> deviating in 130 days of the year. Such manuscripts, despite adopting the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia, would not be said to be the products of the Chalkoprateia Scriptorium. Certainly, we cannot dismiss the possibility that these manuscripts are the products of Chalkoprateia, and that the calendar was strictly specified by the client.

One phenomenon is worth noting: generally, the *encaenia* of the church is described as, e.g., τὰ ἐγκαίνια τῆς Μεγάλης Ἐκκλησίας, but in the case of Chalkoprateia, the *encaenia* is written in a special way as τὰ ἀνοιξίᾳ τῶν ἐγκαίνιων τοῦ ναοῦ τῆς ὑπεραγίας Θεοτόκου ἐν τοῖς Χαλκοπρατίοις. Among the 36, the 20 manuscripts (**D, F, G, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, S, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, h**) adopt this special way of mention; presumably, one could say that these manuscripts are more faithful to the Chalkoprateian tradition. In any case, however, we should not logically ignore the possibility that one manuscript is a faithful copy of a Chalkoprateian manuscript made in another scriptorium.

## Contents of 1 September

Although 1 September marks the beginning of the year, the saints and events celebrated on this day considerably vary in the lectionary manuscripts in general. The Patriarchal Lectionary, Venice, Ist.Ellen., Cod.gr.2, provides the following description: Μηνὶ Σεπτεμβρίῳ Α', ἀρχὴ τῆς ἵνδικτου καὶ μνήμῃ τοῦ ὁσίου Συμεὼν τοῦ Στυλίτου καὶ τοῦ μεγάλου ἐμπρησμοῦ γίνεται δὲ καὶ σύναξις τῆς ὑπεραγίας Θεοτόκου ἐν τοῖς Χαλκοπρατείοις ὑπέρ Μιασινῶν·

καὶ ἐν μὲν τῷ Φόρῳ καὶ εἰς τὴν λειτουργίαν τῆς Μεγάλης Ἐκκλησίας ἀναγινώσκεται ἐναγγέλιον (Lk 4:16-22). Ἐν δὲ τοῖς Χαλκοπρατείοις ἀναγινώσκεται ἐναγγέλιον (Lk 1:39-56). The majority of the 36 manuscripts adopt this same description; in other words, on 1 September, the clergies of the Chalkoprateia Church, collaborating with members of the Patriarchate, would have been executing the long liturgy of the day in St. Sophia, the Forum, and Chalkoprateia.<sup>(13)</sup> Several manuscripts are compared to show the diversity of the selections of 1 September (**Table 4**). Among them, Jerusalem, Hagios Sabas 266 (**MS C**), with the Chalkoprateia *encaenia*, differs in selection from many Chalkoprateian manuscripts; this may be due to the patron's instructions.

### Characteristics of the Lectionaries of the Chalkoprateia Scriptorium

Among the 36 manuscripts, four include colophons; the **MS V**, dated 1052, was written by Clement the Monk for the Monastery of Theotokos tou *Spelaion*<sup>(14)</sup>, for which the calendar does not appear to have a particularly strong significance. The **MS c**, majuscule manuscript of 980, records only the name of the scribe (Nikon or Nikolaos), without information for the patron. The colophon of the **MS B** has no information on the date, scribe and patron. The colophon of the **MS f** only indicates a production date of 1067.

The **MS Z**, adopting the Patriarchal calendar (Paris recension), has unique elements not found elsewhere. On f.251r, after the texts of the *Eothina*, titled as Ἐυαγγέλια ἀναγινωσκόμενα ὑπὸ τοῦ Πατριάρχου καὶ τῶν λοιπῶν ἀρχιερέων, it contains the latter half of the Patriarchal text of the *Taxis kai Akolouthia*.<sup>(15)</sup> This is followed by the first half of the Patriarchal text of the *Taxis kai Akolouthia*, titled as “Μηνὶ Σεπτεμβρίῳ Α’ ἀρχὴ τῆς ινδίκτου”, a detailed description of the 1 September Liturgy (f.251v right column to f.252v right column). The texts are somewhat dissimilar, and in certain cases the **MS Z** is more detailed: ὁ διάκονος λέγει (Patriarchal) and ὁ δεύτερος διάκονος λέγει (**Z**). It is worth noting that the citations of the Pauline Epistles are different: instead of 1 Timothy 2:1 (Patriarchal), it is Colossians 3:12-16 (**Z**), and instead of Hebrews 2:11 (Patriarchal), it is Galatians 5:22 (**Z**). Although the calendar of the **MS Z** is almost identical with the Patriarchal Lectionary (Paris.gr.286), the Paris Lectionary adopts 1 Timothy and Hebrews in the *Taxis kai Akolouthia*. The **MS Z** may maintain an older tradition than the Paris Lectionary. The manuscript ends here, and there may have been a colophon after this, now erased and illegible. Despite the first and second halves being interchanged and placed at the end of the manuscript, instead of before the immovable feasts, the **MS Z** contains the Patriarchal text of the *Taxis kai Akolouthia*. The long rite of 1 September of the New Year is executed by the Patriarchate and the Chalkoprateia Church in cooperation, moving from one place to another: the Forum, St. Sophia, and Chalkoprateia. This required close collaboration between the two, and since the **MS Z** has no *encaenia* specific to the Patriarchate, it cannot be assumed that it was used in the Patriarchate; it was likely utilized by the clergies of Chalkoprateia to collaborate with the Patriarchate.

The **MS B**, *Praxapostolos* with liturgical instructions, has been used frequently in the church; the parchment is darkened from years of use, and the ink has worn away considerably. On the days of 22 December (*Anoixia* of St. Sophia)<sup>(16)</sup>, 1 January (Circumcision and St. Basil)<sup>(17)</sup> and 5 January (*Paramone* of Theophaneia)<sup>(18)</sup>, the Patriarch's

movements in St. Sophia are described<sup>(19)</sup>. Among the 36, six manuscripts are *Praxapostolos*, of which five manuscripts (**A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**) include detailed liturgical instructions. Gregory-Aland's symbols (Apostels<sup>c</sup>, Apostels<sup>e-sk</sup>, +Apostels<sup>c</sup>, etc.) only describe the content of the biblical text, and do not refer to the presence of liturgical instructions; without opening the manuscript, the contents cannot be determined. Interestingly, all five *Praxapostolos* manuscripts are considerably used and blackened. While a manuscript with full-page miniatures, used as an icon or reliquary, is often well preserved, the *Praxapostolos* manuscripts with liturgical instructions were ordered for practical use and had actually been used in the churches for many years. It is a high probability that five of the 36 manuscripts are *Praxapostolos* with liturgical instruction; the Chalkoprateia Scriptorium had the expertise to meet such special orders, and it would have been possible to produce a manuscript with the liturgical information required by the client. The **MS N** is bilingual in Greek and Arabic; the Chalkoprateia Scriptorium was also able to fulfill such an order.

## The Other *Encaenia* of the Manuscripts

As noted above, among the 36 manuscripts, 11 also include the *encaenia* of the Church of St. Theodore *en tois Sphorakiou* (**a**, **b**, **c**, **d**, **e**, **f**, **g**, **h**, **i**, **j**, **C**) and 16 adopt the *encaenia* of the Church of the Virgin *en te Pege* (**h**, **A**, **D**, **F**, **I**, **J**, **K**, **M**, **N**, **O**, **P**, **Q**, **S**, **U**, **V**, **W**); the **MS h** records the three *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia, Sphorakiou and Pege. The calendars of the Sphorakiou Group and the Pege Group do not show any distinguishing features; what does this fact suggest? One logical hypothesis is the following: the Sphorakiou Church and the Pege Church were affiliated with the Chalkoprateia Church, and both had scriptoria. The lectionaries by those scriptoria were produced using the same models as those of Chalkoprateia. Instead of writing a colophon, they included the *encaenia* of their own churches in the calendar. To examine this hypothesis, paleographical data would be necessary: if the three churches collaborated in the procurement and preparation of materials, the codicological condition could be the same.

I assumed that the feast of Theotokos *en te Petra* (21 Sept.) and the feast of Theotokos *en tois Kyrou* (4 Nov.) would be *panegyria* for prominent icons, not *encaenia*.<sup>(20)</sup> Among the 36 manuscripts, 10 adopt the feast of the Virgin in Petra (**C**, **H**, **Z**, **a**, **b**, **c**, **d**, **e**, **f**, **g**), and 10 of the Virgin in Kyrou (**Z**, **a**, **b**, **c**, **d**, **e**, **f**, **g**, **i**, **j**); eight manuscripts include both feasts (**Z**, **a**, **b**, **c**, **d**, **e**, **f**, **g**). This may be due to the instructions of the patrons.

The **MS Z**, with the Patriarchal calendar (Paris recension), selects only Chalkoprateia out of the five *encaenia* adopted by the Patriarchate. The text of the *Taxis kai Akolouthia* is included at the end of the manuscript to serve as a link between the Patriarchate and the Chalkoprateia Church, but the calendar content is specialized for Chalkoprateia. Conversely, the **MS a**, with the Patriarchal calendar (Venice recension), adopts four of the five Patriarchal *encaenia*; in other words, only the Palatine Church (*naos tou Palatiou*, 1 Dec.) is deleted. The **MS a** has a stronger Patriarchal character.

The **MS C** designates the place where the liturgy is to take place for three dates: Polyeuktos, *he lite eis ton Hagion Polyeukton* (9 Jan.)<sup>(21)</sup>; Ephraim, *en to martyrio tes Hagias Akyline* (28 Jan.)<sup>(22)</sup>; Neophytos, Gaios, Gaiane, *en toi oikoi ton hagion Kosma kai Damianou en Blach(ernais)* (5 May)<sup>(23)</sup>.

## Two Additional Chalkoprateian Lectionaries

In addition to the 36 manuscripts with the *encaenia* of Chalkoprateia, two more lectionary manuscripts pertaining to the Chalkoprateia Church exist: Cod.Paris.Suppl.gr.1096 (AD 1070)<sup>(24)</sup> and Athos, Iviron Monastery Cod.1<sup>(25)</sup>.

The former, with the luxurious frontispiece of the Four Evangelists (f.1v), was written by Petros, grammaticos of the School of Chalkoprateia (γραμματικός τῆς σχολῆς τῶν Χαλκοπρατείων) for the Presbyteros Konstantinos. The selection of saints is closer to the Patriarchal calendar rather than the hypothetical calendar of Chalkoprateia. It should be noted that Petros adopted the *encaenia* of Nea Ekklesia, and not Chalkoprateia; if the entity ordering the manuscript, Konstantinos the Presbyteros, is a cleric belonging to Nea Ekklesia, this phenomenon can be clearly explained. The relationship between the School and the Scriptorium in Chalkoprateia is unclear; Petros was a skilled scribe, so it is likely that he was related to the scriptorium. It is probable that the scriptorium belonged to the “School” or that the “School” was the scriptorium itself.

The latter is a manuscript whose *encaenia* indicates that it was produced for the Chapel of St. James in Chalkoprateia<sup>(26)</sup>, and I discussed the contents of the calendar in detail in my previous article. The Iviron Lectionary has many omissions in the immovable feasts, probably because the small chapel was not required to conduct daily liturgies. However, significant differences exist in its calendar from the Patriarchal and Chalkoprateian calendars (compare the contents in **Table 3**): +Agapetos, Theopistos, Theopiste (20 Sept., common with the **MSS H, e, f, i**); Kornelios (20 Oct., **C, H, c, d, f, g, i, j**); +Auxentios, Eugenios, Orestes, Mardarios (13 Dec., **C, c, i, j**); Abraam, Isaak, Iakob, 3 Children, Daniel (Sunday before Christmas, **A**); Anastasios (20 Apr., **B, Y**); the Lord’s Brothers Iakobos, Ioseph, Symeon, Ioudas, and Martha and Maria (24 Apr., no parallel in the Chalkoprateian Lectionaries<sup>(27)</sup>); +Iakobos Brother of the Lord (30 Apr., **H, N**); Andreas (4 May, **j**); Synaxis of Michael in Systhenio (9 Jun., no parallel<sup>(28)</sup>); Michael, Gabriel and all other Archangels (22 Jun., no parallel); Aristokles-syn. (23 Jun., **A**); Kyrillos (27 Jun., no parallel<sup>(29)</sup>); Ioustos, Matthias (21 Jul., **A**); +Alexandros (29 Jul., **A**); +150 Fathers of the Second Council (3 Aug., no parallel<sup>(30)</sup>); Maria tes Magdalenes (4 Aug., no parallel<sup>(31)</sup>); 70 Apostles (11 Aug., no parallel); Thaddaios (19 Aug., **g**); Eustathios (23 Aug., no parallel<sup>(32)</sup>). The feasts on 22 Jun. (Michael, Gabriel and all other Archangels) and 11 Aug. (70 Apostles) can be said to be quite unusual; it is difficult to imagine that the Chapel of St. James had its own rite that differed from either Chalkoprateia or St. Sophia, and presently, I cannot propose a hypothesis to explain this fact.

The research on scriptoria using colophons appears to have already run its course. Therefore, this article proposes the use of a new element of *encaenia* in the lectionary.

Table 2 Overlapping relationship of the encaenia Chalkoprateia


