This summer, the GSPS is offering an intensive program in cooperation with the Missouri School of Journalism, the theme being “Global Communication.” The program will examine the structure and transformation of modern Japanese culture, discussing the movement of goods, ideas, and peoples within East Asia and in interaction with the West, particularly the United States of America. It will also look at the major global forces of nationalism, capitalism, socialism, and consumerism, investigating how these forces interact with Japan’s cultural production. One particular aim of this course is to provide a forum for students to explore together the commonalities and specificities of the production of national culture in both the past and the present.
