1. Documents to be submitted

2. Where to submit: Your School Office <u>Deadline: April 24th, Friday</u>

3. Postal Savings Account Information

In order to receive the Honors Scholarship, you have to open an ordinary savings account at Japan Post Bank and submit the "Postal Savings Account Information" to your school office before the deadline.

4. Description of Scholarship (these are subject to change)

1) Scholarship amount: 48,000 yen/month (for undergraduate students)

65,000 yen/month (for graduate students)

2) Scholarship duration: April 2014 through March 2015 (12 months)

3) Eligibility: Students who meet all of the following conditions.

(1) Privately financed international students who are currently enrolled as regular students.

(2) Students whose residency status is "College Student" or who can change it to "College Student" in a few days.

(3) Students recognized as both academically and personally outstanding who are having difficulty pursuing their studies for economic reasons and are acknowledged to be in need of financial support

(4) Students whose total amount from other scholarships is less than the amount of the stipend from this scholarship per month

(5) Students whose average allowance is 90,000 yen or less per month except school fees

(6) If students have financial supporters living in Japan, those annual income is less than 5 million yen

(7) Students who cooperate the survey of academic and carrier status after scholarship payment.

- When you apply, please show your student ID card and certificate of alien registration or resident card (to confirm your college student visa).

- If you are selected as a recipient, the first scholarship payment for April, May, and June will be made on July 15th, Tuesday together.

- You need to sign up on "the sheet of enrollment" every month at the office of your undergraduate or graduate school to receive monthly scholarship.
