Special Admission Application Guidelines

[Fall 2021 Admission]

In order to nurture specialized researchers with sophisticated research skills among those candidates with a strong desire to proceed to the Doctoral Program, the Graduate School of Political Science expedites the admissions process by offering Special Admission to graduates of the Master's Program/Professional Degree Program of GSPS.

1. Admissions Quota: Strictly limited

2. Application Requirements:

Candidates must meet all the requirements listed below.

- 1) Be a current student in the Master's Program or the Professional Degree Program of the Graduate School of Political Science.
- 2) Be on schedule to complete in September 2021 and submit master's thesis or research paper in Fall AY2021.
- 3) Have passed the Analytical Method Certification Examination.

3. Application period: June 12 ~ June 15, 2021

4. Application Procedures:

Submit the application to the GSPS Office in person* during the application period, or post** by delivery-certified mail (kan-i kakitome yuubin).

**Applications must ARRIVE by deadline to be accepted.

5. Application Documents

1) Application Forms [Prescribed Forms]

2) Research Plan [Prescribed Form]

You must complete the whole description of the research plan within 5 pages of Japanese or 10 pages of English.

3) A copy of Notification of the Result of the Analytical Method Certification Examination (in order to prove that you passed the examination.)

4) English Examination Score Card:

- Please submit an official score card from one of the following language examinations.
A copy of the score card is acceptable, and applicants are allowed to submit more than one score cards.
 - TOEFL: iBT or PBT (Examinee Score Report / Test Taker Score Report)
 - TOEIC: a TOEIC(IP) score is not acceptable
 - IELTS
- TOEFL/TOEIC/IELTS must have been taken no more than 2 years before the application deadline.
- Applicants who satisfied following reference point when they applied for master program in Graduate School of Political Science can submit same score that they have submitted.
TOEFL iBT 80 , TOEIC 800, IELTS 6.7
- Native speakers of English are not required to submit a score card.
- Applicants who have received a degree from an English-based degree program at an institute of higher education (university or higher) are not required to submit test results.

*You do not have to submit a copy of either your Master's Thesis or your Master's Thesis Outline.

*For the purpose of administering entrance exams in an efficient manner and carrying out admission procedures, Waseda University collects information regarding your gender on legal documents. The information is collected only when the reason is deemed reasonable, and these cases are limited to a minimum.

7. **Examinations:** Document Screening , Oral Examination

8. **Examination Card:** Examination cards will be sent to each applicant via email, by June 25, 2021.

9. **Oral Examination Date:** June 30~ July 7, 2021 *Excluding July 4

- The oral examination date and the method of conducting the test will be announced by the GSPS.
- The oral examination may be conducted using a web conference system (such as Zoom). Please set up your internet connection, and prepare a personal computer and audio equipment in advance.

10. **Announcement of results:** July 23, 2021, 10:00 a.m.

- The results of the examinations will be posted on the website of the Graduate School of Political Science.

11. **Entrance Procedures:** July 26 ~ August 6, 2021

- The details of the entrance procedure and the essential documents are described on the manual for "the entrance procedures" which is sent to applicants who passed examination.
- As a rule, we do not return submitted documents or refund school expenses and fees (the entrance fee and school expenses for the first semester). However, if you do not enter Waseda University due to unavoidable circumstances or fail to meet the entrance qualifications prior to enrollment, we may refund the school expenses for the first semester alone (though not the entrance fee). For more information about the procedure for receiving such refunds, refer to the handbook on entrance procedures mailed to successful applicants.

12. **Important Notes:**

- No examination fee is required for the Special Admission application.
- You cannot apply for General Examination for Doctoral Program as well as Special Examination simultaneously.
- You may be deemed to have committed a dishonest act if you falsified, fabricated, or plagiarized a document, material, or information submitted in your application. In such a case, any decision taken regarding your application may later be invalidated, without the application documents and screening fee being returned.
- If you expect to require special care during the entrance examination or after entering the university due to a disability or serious medical condition, etc., please contact the GSPS Office immediately. In addition, contact us if a serious injury or illness is expected to affect your ability to take the entrance examination. Please contact us immediately even if you find yourself in such situation after submitting your application.

[Notes]

1. The entrance fee (admission fee) is not required if those who enrolled, graduated, or withdrew from an undergraduate school or graduate school of Waseda University enter the university again.
2. Graduates of the Graduate School of Political Science, Graduate School of Economics or School of Political Science and Economics will be exempt from paying the society enrollment fee.
3. Other fees are subject to change without notice.
4. Please note that the seminar fee and other fees may be changed.

14. Other Notes:

Waseda University utilizes applicant information (addresses, names, dates of birth, etc.) collected at the time of application in order to carry out operations such as the entrance examination, announcement of the screening results, and enrollment procedures. We will take necessary and proper measures to protect such information from leakage, disclosure or unauthorized use. All or part of the above operations may be outsourced to an agency. In such cases, the agency will be contractually required to maintain necessary and proper management. Please note that the personal information may be used as materials for studies and research to improve our entrance examinations. The information will be statistically processed to prevent any individuals from being identified.

If you expect to require special care during the entrance examination or after entering the university due to a disability or serious medical condition, etc., please contact the Graduate School of Political Science Office at Waseda University immediately. In addition, contact us if a serious injury or illness is expected to affect your ability to take the entrance examination. Please contact us immediately even if you find yourself in such a situation after submitting your application.

Waseda University has provided the following guidelines so that all examinations can be properly administered and all examinees have an opportunity to perform in a fair and equitable environment. Please read the guidelines carefully and approach the examination in a serious manner.

1. You may be deemed to have committed a dishonest act if Waseda University determines that you have falsified, fabricated or plagiarized the document(s), statement(s) or information submitted for your application.
2. Your actions may be considered dishonest if you commit any of the following acts:
 - ① Cheating (concealing or glancing at a cheat sheet or reference book during the examination, glancing at another examinee's answer sheet, or gaining answers from others)
 - ② Providing benefits to other examinees (providing them with answers, etc.) during the examination
 - ③ Keeping your mobile phone with you or using it during the examination
 - ④ Letting your mobile phone or watch emit noise (incoming call alert, alarm, vibration, etc.) during the examination
 - ⑤ Conducting acts that could be considered a nuisance to other examinees at the examination venue
 - ⑥ Not following instructions from the examination supervisors at the examination venue

- ⑦ Pretending to be an applicant and taking the examination for the actual applicant
 - ⑧ Conducting other acts impairing the fairness of the examination
3. The following responses may be taken if an applicant is suspected of committing a dishonest act:
 - A supervisor may warn or question the applicant.
 - The applicant may be requested to take the examination in another room.
 4. In addition, the following responses may be taken if a dishonest act is identified:
 - The applicant may not be allowed to continue taking the examination or allowed to take any other entrance examination given by Waseda University during that year. (Screening fees will not be returned.)
 - The results of all entrance examinations taken by the applicant at Waseda University during that year may become invalid.

<Privacy Policy>

Personal information submitted to Waseda University in association with applications (including a name, a date of birth, and an address) will be used in the conducting of admissions examinations, announcement of results, performance of admission procedures, and associated activities. At such time, this information will be administered as necessary and appropriate to ensure that it is not leaked, divulged or improperly used.

Some or all of the above activities may be outsourced to other parties, in which case these parties will be required by contract or other arrangement to ensure that personal information is administered as necessary and appropriate.

Statistics treated personal information is used as a document of the research for the new student selection so that an individual is not identified.

< Unforeseen problems that are beyond human control>

In cases of unforeseen circumstances that are beyond human control, such as natural disasters (e.g., typhoons, earthquakes, flooding, tsunami) and/or accident, such as fire, power failure, and so on, measures including delaying the start of the exam or postponing the exam, etc., may be taken. However, in such an event, we will bear no responsibility for any resulting inconvenience, expense, or other personal loss that the examinee may incur.

<Infectious diseases>

Applicants who, in accordance with School Health and Safety Act, have been forbidden from attending classes due to as of yet untreated cases of infectious diseases (such as COVID-19, influenza, measles, rubella, etc.), and who may consequently prove a threat to other applicants and proctors of the examination, are asked not to attend the examination. Note that, for those unable to attend the examination for this (or any other) reason, there will be no make-up examination, and your screening fee will not be returned to you.
