Application Guidelines: Scholarship for Young Doctoral Students For April Enrollees (newly admitted students and currently enrolled students) and For September Enrollees (who took a leave of absence in fall semester of 2020)

[NOTE] By the effects of COVID-19, we continue partially changing the way of application document preparation and submission for this Academic Year 2021.

### Overview of the scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2009 to help students currently enrolled in a doctoral program to become outstanding young scholars with superior research capabilities and extensive knowledge of their fields. As shown in the table below, each graduate school will select the recipients from the students who fulfill all the requirements indicated in the following section (2.Eligibility) and submit the application documents.

\*Graduate School of Japanese Applied Linguistics will not accept application in Spring semester. Application period for Fall semester will start from late October.

### 1. How and when to apply

Application period: June 7, 2021(Monday) through July 2, 2021(Friday)

# How to apply: Submit all the required application documents listed in 3 below to the office of your graduate school by email.

When you email your application to your Graduate School office, please name the title as "Application Documents of Scholarship for Young Doctoral Students".

\*Please note that no applications will be accepted after the deadline.

\*We will distribute the application guidelines and start to accept applications from late October for September enrollees enrolled in or enrolling after academic year 2009 (with the exception of those re-enrolling and transfer students).

\*The amount of this scholarship applies to one academic year. If you would like this scholarship to continue in the next academic year as well, you must meet the application qualifications for the next academic year and apply again. The scholarship does not continue automatically into the next academic year.

## 2. Eligibility

Students who meet ALL the following four requirements, (1) through (4)

(1) 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> year doctoral students and 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> year doctoral students enrolled in a consistent five-year doctoral program (actual course year: based on the length of enrollment excluding leaves of absence and study abroad) who are April enrollees enrolled in or enrolling after academic year 2009 (with the exception of those re-enrolling and transfer students), or those who are September enrollees enrolled in or enrolling after academic year 2009 and took a leave of absence in the fall semester of 2020.

However, students who have received the grants three times (Consistent five-year doctoral program : five times) are not eligible to apply.

\* September enrollees who took a leave of absence for the fall semester of 2020 and returned to school for the spring semester of 2021 are eligible to receive this scholarship only for the spring semester. They must follow the application guidelines of the fall semester of 2021 in order to apply for this scholarship for the fall semester of 2022.

- (2) Students under 30 years of age as of April 1, 2021 (born on April 2, 1991 or later)
- (3) Students who have received recommendations from two academic staff (one from your chief research project advisor and another from a full-time faculty member, except faculty members who are NOT on tenure.

Those recommenders must **write their names** as well as completing other information in the <u>"Academic Staff Recommender 1" and "Academic Staff Recommender 2" sections</u> of the prescribed forms.

- (4) Students in any of the following categories cannot apply:
- ① Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) government sponsored international students
- ② Waseda University research associate
- ③ Part-time lecturer at Waseda University Senior High School, Waseda University Honjo Senior High School, Waseda University Art and Architecture School of Waseda University
- ④ Recipients of a Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) Research Fellowship for Young Scientists
- ⑤ Recipients of other **full** tuition waivers (school fee waived due to disasters, etc. or other reasons)
- 6 Students receiving full Waseda University tuition (or a full reduction) from a government, corporation or scholarship foundation
  - \*There are cases where those paying a portion of their own tuition (including help from parents) are eligible to apply. Please contact the Scholarships and Financial Assistance Section for more information.
- $\bigcirc$  Students on a leave of absence
  - \*Those who will take a leave of absence for the fall semester of this year are eligible to apply. They need to apply at this time.

\*For students who take a leave of absence for the spring semester of this year and return to school in the fall semester of the same year, they will need to follow the application guidelines of the fall semester of this year to apply (guidelines will be informed around late October).

- [Note] If one or more of the conditions in (4)① through ⑦ becomes applicable to you during April 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 to March 31<sup>st</sup> 2022, it will be necessary to return the full amount (or a portion of the amount) of the scholarship.
  - Even if you fulfill the "2.Eligibility" at the time of application, it will be necessary to return the full amount (or a portion of the amount) of the scholarship when you do not meet the requirements from April 1<sup>st</sup> 2021 to March 31<sup>st</sup> 2022.

Please contact the Scholarships and Financial Assistance Section if you should fall under the situation as stated above.

# 3. Required Application Documents

Prepare all the documents in (1) and (2) below and submit the application during the specified application period.

#### (1) Scholarship for Young Doctoral Students Application Form (Prescribed Form 1)

- Please correctly complete the separate prescribed form.
- Please fill in everything, leaving no items blank.
  - Please fill in the "Research Project" or "Research Project Status" in details.
    - First year students: Describe your research project in details.
    - Second year students and above: Please describe your research project and the status in details.
       \*For Second year students and above, if they describe only research project, the application will not be acceptable.
- If there is not enough space in the ""Research Project" or "Research Project Status"" section, attach a separate sheet as an additional document.

\*You cannot leave a required field incomplete or mark it as "See the next page".

- (2) Scholarship Student Recommendation Form & Confirmation Form for Information on Application (Research Project, etc.) (Prescribed Form 2)
- For the first recommender, please ask your chief research project advisor to write a recommendation, sign the form, and add his/her seal.
- Details of research project (for First year Students) or research project status (for Second year or above students) have to be described in the column of "Recommendation".

\*Please inform your chief research advisor about this requirement when you request


- For the second recommender - (first year students) Please ask a second reader, associate dean, or full-time faculty member of Waseda University (except those who are NOT on tenure), such as the dean of the graduate school, involved with your Master's thesis to admit.

- (second year or above students) Please request a full-time faculty member at Waseda University such as someone in the same field to admit.

\*If you do not have a second academic staff recommender, please consult with the office of your graduate school.

# [Note] If we should find anything fraudulent in your application documents, you will be disqualified from this scholarship application and it will have influence on your application eligibility for this scholarship in the future.

# 5. Check, register and/or change your scholarship bank account information

Applicants must check and/or change the registered information for the ordinary bank account under the name of the student (\*see note) (some financial institutions cannot be used, such as online banks, trust banks, etc.) in the "Personal Account" screen in the MyWaseda by July 2 (Friday). If your bank account is not registered or is inactive, etc., the scholarship will not be paid out even if you are selected as a recipient. Please note that if we cannot confirm your scholarship bank account, this scholarship award may be withdrawn.

\*Follow Steps (1) through (3) below to confirm, register and/or change your scholarship bank account information. (Japanese version only)

- (1) Log into the MyWaseda, and click "Update Student Profile" in 'View/Update Your Own Profile' listed in the menu on the left.
- (2) Check your "Personal Account" information in the "Edit Personal Information" page.
- (3) In the rare event <u>that your account is not registered (or is inactive, for reasons including bank</u> <u>or branch consolidation)</u>, please be sure to accurately register a new account (or change your <u>account information</u>).

# 6. Schedule after Application

The schedule after you submit your application documents to the office of your graduate school is shown below. Be sure to check and follow the procedures, as each step is important.
