Changes to the requirements of Score card of English Proficiency For AY2026 and onward

The Graduate School of Political Science has decided to make the following changes to the requirements of Score card of English Proficiency of the entrance examination for General Admissions for Master's Program / Internal Admissions by Recommendation for Master's Program / General Admissions for Doctoral Program for the 2026 academic year and onwards.

[Before the change]

Applicants who are nationals of countries where English is an official language or have received a degree from an English-based degree program at an institute of higher education (university or higher) are not required to submit a test score card. In addition, any applicants who complete English-based program outside English-speaking countries, must submit a certificate which proves that they complete English-based program.

[After the change]

Applicants who are nationals of countries where English is an official language are not required to submit a test score card. Those who have obtained a degree (bachelor's degree or higher) through an English curriculum but who are not citizens of a country where English is the official language must submit a test score card.
