

Class Advisor

1. What is the class advisor system?

The School of Political Science and Economics provides a class advisor for first- and second-year students. Students are able to seek advice regarding academic or school life from their advisor.

2. Who is my class advisor?

The instructor of “Fresh-Start Seminar” is the main advisor for the two years. When the advisor is not available due to sabbatical leave or other reasons, the associate deans of the School will take care of you.

If you wish to see your advisor, contact the instructor to make an appointment in advance and visit their office. For the instructor’s contact information, come to the SPSE Office or ask the instructor in class.

3. Other student consultation services

There are other ways to consult issues that arise in university life such as the SPSE Office counter, talks with associate deans of student affairs, and the Health Center Student Consultation Room.

You can choose the service that most suits your concern and that you feel most comfortable. Please don’t worry by yourself and consult us at an early stage.
