Faculty of Political Science and Economics, Waseda University Faculty Recruitment Information (Macroeconomics)

Waseda University, a long-established private university located in central Tokyo, invites applications for **one full-time, tenure-track* (or tenured*) position in Macroeconomics** in the Faculty of Political Science and Economics. The appointment will be made at the rank of either Associate Professor or (full) Professor, beginning on September 1, 2018, or April 1, 2019.

The successful candidate for the tenure-track position will be a promising junior scholar. Applicants for the position must demonstrate a record of research accomplishments consistent with their career stage. Applicants considered for the tenured position should have an excellent record of publications, including those in high-quality peer-reviewed journals.

*The tenure status of the appointment will be determined by the applicant's teaching experience and research achievements, as well as performance during the recruitment process. The initial term for the tenure-track position is three years, with a possible extension of two years after evaluation in an interim review that takes place during the second or third year. Tenure may be granted at any time during the years on the tenure-track if deemed appropriate in the tenure review. The procedures and regulations for tenure and promotion will be explained after shortlisting. The terms of the appointment will be detailed in the final interview with the Dean.

1. Field: Macroeconomics

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- (1) Be competent to conduct research in Macroeconomics.
- (2) Be competent to teach courses and conduct thesis advice/supervision regarding Macroeconomics at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels.
- (3) Have a Ph.D. in hand or its equivalent in research experience.
- (4) Have prior teaching experience at university level (desirable rather than required).
- (5) Be able to teach in English.
- (6) Be able to teach in Japanese (desirable rather than required).

2. Working Conditions

- (1) The salary will be determined based on the University salary table, of which candidates will be informed in the second round of interviews.
- (2) Teaching load: Approximately 4 class periods per week (not 4 courses, but 4 class meetings per week; 1 class period is 90 minutes) for 15 weeks in each semester. Note:
 - Approximately 6 class periods a week for a tenured position.
 - The University has adopted a 2-semester (spring and fall) academic calendar.
- (3) Required to be at the University 4 days a week, working 8 hours a day on average.
- (4) Other working conditions will be determined by "Working Rules for Faculty of Waseda University" or "Work Regulations for Faculty without Tenure."

3. Application procedure

- (3) Statement on Research: Use Template Form (C) and upload it to "(3) Additional application material 1."
- (4) Three major pieces of academic research: Use Template Form (D) and upload it to "(3) Additional application material 2."
- (5) Statement on Teaching: Attach sample syllabuses for both an intermediate Macroeconomics course at undergraduate level and a Macroeconomics course for first-year graduate students. Use Template Form (E) and upload it to "(3) Additional application material 3."
- (6) Doctoral degree certificate (in PDF format) to be uploaded to "(3) Additional application material 4."

4. Deadline for application

Online application must be completed no later than 13:00 on November 15, 2017 (Japanese Standard Time).

Receipt of application will be sent within 10 days after the deadline via email.

5. The recruitment process

The recruitment process will include three stages: 1) shortlisting; 2) a campus visit, including a mock lecture, research presentation, and an interview with the search committee (in English); and 3) an interview with the Dean. The result of the first screening will be communicated to candidates by the end of December 2017.
